30 Credits Total from South Kitsap High School = High School Diploma

Plus WA State History

Plus A High School and Beyond Plan (Xello)

Plus A Graduation Pathway (or substituted personal pathway if approved)



Each semester you are **EARNING** a total of **4 credits**

So.... if you do the math. 4 credits per semester,
You have 8 credits a year and I'm in school for 4 years...
equals **32 credits** .

I thought you said we need 30 credits to graduate?!

- You do **NEED** 30, but you need the **RIGHT** 30 credits to graduate.

VARIOUS OPTIONS TO REACH A PATHWAY INCLUDE ONE OF ...

- **CTE Sequence Pathway:** 2 credits in CTE program area
- **Military Career:** ASVAB score of 31 or greater
- **Postsecondary Education Goal:** English & Math scores from testing
 - **ACT:** ELA N/A Math 16
 - **ACT w/ Writing:** ELA 14 Math 16
 - **SAT/ w/ writing:** ELA 410 Math 430
- **Dual Credit:** AP English/Math course(s) with a C+ OR a 3 or higher AP exam score
- **Smarter Balance:** ELA 2548 (3 or higher) Math 2595 (3 or higher)
- **Transition Course:** Passing grade in Bridge to College, Running Start ENG/Math

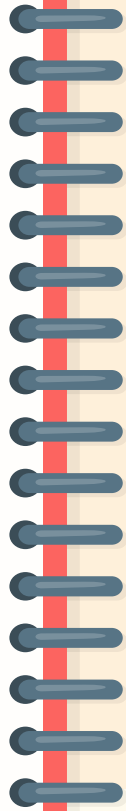

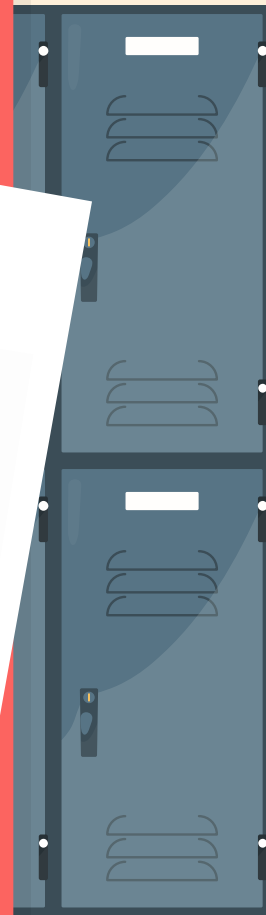
HIGH SCHOOL and BEYOND PLAN (HSBP)

EQUIVALENCY CREDIT

If you fail first semester of a YEAR LONG class, but you pass the second semester, you can earn a “P” credit for semester one.

However, if you plan to go to a UNIVERSITY right after high school, you will want to retake the class. Universities will not recognize a “P” on a transcript - they want to see a grade.

Whereas, if you are considering going to a community college first, you only need a high school diploma to do that.











Running Start

Please look in the google classroom at the Running Start post. This may answer some of your questions. You will register for classes for BOTH SKHS AND Running Start just in case you change your mind in the fall.

You can take up to 4 classes at OC each quarter IF you don't take any classes here. You need to take classes at OC that are equivalent to your core classes here. English, Math, Science and US History. Please look at the OC course planner to see what other classes may interest you and note if there's any prerequisites.



College in the HS

SK has partnerships with CWU, UW and EWU. CiHS allows students to take college courses from approved high school instructors without leaving campus.

Credits are free. Students get more opportunity to explore courses of interest. If you are interested in taking CiHS course, you just sign up for it when registering. Math courses have prerequisites, such as passing a previous course or taking the Accuplacer at SKHS.
