


ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS



- 18 ACT composite,
- 970 SAT, or
- ONE of the following Accuplacer scores: 250 Reading, 263 Writing, or 263 QAS (Math)





Accuplacer testing is available at the AU Testing Center, ashland.edu/testing-center.

CHECKLIST

 Application – by June 15th, but by April 1st is best!
DO NOT use a HS email account!
Transcript – Ask your counselor, or use a transcript service (Parchment, etc.)
Permission Slip – Upload to your application!

Test Scores? You probably won't need to test, unless:

- ✓ You haven't yet completed the 9th grade.
- ✓ Your HS GPA is between 2.50 and 2.99.
- \checkmark You want to take math and haven't taken the ACT.

The deadline to test is June 30th, 2025.



PARTICIPATION

Current, active students in good standing do not need to reapply to continue taking courses,

HOWEVER

You will need to submit another application, IF:

- You applied for a previous semester and were accepted but never participated.
- It has been 365 days or longer since you completed your last course.

SCHOLARSHIP



All high school students (in the Class of 2024 and beyond) who are enrolled in the College Credit Plus program at AU and matriculate directly from high school into a bachelor's program will receive a yearly \$1,000 scholarship (\$500 to be awarded in the fall semester and \$500 in the spring semester). This scholarship is renewable yearly (for up to four years or \$4,000) and is stackable upon other scholarships/aid.
