<sup>1</sup> The annual dropout rate is based on the number of students in grades 7-12 who permanently left school during a specified reporting year and is based on the fall membership for that year. The annual dropout rate is lower than the cohort dropout rate because the denominator is based on all students in grades 7-12.

<sup>2</sup> A cohort is a group of first-time ninth-grade students followed over the course of their four-year high school career. The cohort dropout rate reflects the percentage of students in this group who left high school permanently over the course of four years or who cannot be accounted for elsewhere. The cohort dropout rate is higher than the annual dropout rate because the denominator is based only on the cohort of first-time ninth graders who entered in a given year.
