- Dual enrollment credits provide seamless pathways to several Associate Degrees (AA) .

COURSES AND CREDITS

Glendale Community College (GCC) Dual Enrollment Credits available at Northwest and Southwest Campus. Dual Enrollment is not available to high school graduates and students with a GED.

Pima Medical Institute (PMI)

COST REQUIREMENTS

GCC

- \$15 registration fee per semester
- \$97 per credit hour due soon after classes begin
 - Cost based upon meeting Maricopa residency and U.S. citizen/legal residency criteria (Must complete "Maricopa Community Colleges Student Declaration of Citizenship or Status" form. Visit www.maricopa.edu/residency)
- For dual enrollment grant availability, check with the Maricopa Community Colleges and West-MEC.
- Courses taken under dual enrollment may impact federal financial aid eligibility. To obtain additional information, students are encouraged to inquire with the college or university where they intend to enroll.

ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

- Students that withdraw from the West-MEC program may receive college credit based on the number of completed courses.
