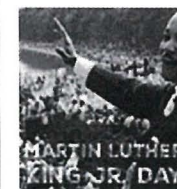

To Parents & Guardians,

In the event of cancellations, delayed openings, and early dismissals, the following radio and TV stations will be notified as early as possible.

Our automated telephone calling system will contact you if there is a delay, cancellation, or early dismissal. **Please be sure that schools have your current telephone number on file.**

DELAYED OPENING HOURS

All delayed openings will be 2 hours. When there is a 2-hour delay, there is no breakfast program, and no morning preschool and a child's bus will be delayed by the same amount of time. For example, a student who is usually picked up at 7:00 a.m. will be picked up at 9:00 a.m.

Goodyear (School-day only) -10:45 a.m. (no a.m. preschool)
KCP (Killingly Childcare Program) grades PK-4 opens at 8:00 a.m., no breakfast will be served.

EARLY DISMISSAL HOURS

KHS-12:10 p.m. KIS-12:10 p.m. KCS-1:20p.m. KMS-1:20 p.m.

Goodyear: Pre-K morning students will be dismissed at the usual time, 11:15. Dismissal for full-day Pre-K students will be at 12:45 p.m. There is no afternoon (PM) preschool.
Killingly Childcare Program is open until 5:30 p.m., unless otherwise directed by the Superintendent.

HOURS FOR CHILDCARE PROGRAMS (KCP) WHEN SCHOOLS ARE CLOSED/CANCELLED

Killingly Childcare Program or KCP for students in grades PK-6 will be available starting at 8:00am-5:30pm.
If the DISTRICT is closed, All Main Offices and Childcare Programs are also closed.

In rare circumstances the Superintendent may elect to have a **SPECIAL EARLY DISMISSAL** and dismiss students about one hour earlier than a typical early dismissal schedule. Many storms in the past have intensified around 2:30 p.m. When there is a **SPECIAL EARLY DISMISSAL**, there is no afternoon preschool.
The Killingly Childcare Program sites are open until 5:30 p.m. unless otherwise directed by the Superintendent.

SPECIAL EARLY DISMISSAL HOURS: KHS-10:55 a.m. KIS-10:55 a.m. KCS-12:05 p.m. KMS-12:05 p.m.
Goodyear: Pre-K morning students will be dismissed at 10:45 a.m. Dismissal for full-day PK students will be at 11:30 a.m. There will be no afternoon preschool session. This schedule will have an impact on lunch for students, create a condensed schedule, and may require staff members lunch/prep times to be moved to the end of the day. School principals will set forth a schedule that is appropriate for each building.

Parents of Elementary and Intermediate students should make arrangements to receive students at home in the event of an early dismissal. Arrange to be home early, or arrange for a relative or neighbor to provide supervision. Parents need to let schools know of any changes for early dismissal. Please inform your child of your plans in the case of an early dismissal.
