We have exciting news! The West Shore YMCA is collaborating with the Northern York County School District (NYCSD) to resume offering aquatic programming to community residents at Northern High School! Spread the word!

The YMCA's program will initially offer swim lessons for ages 3-12 years. Working with NYCSD, the Y is preparing for Spring 2025 lessons.

The **Spring 1** session dates will begin the week of March 3 and end the week of April 21. Registration for this session will begin Monday February 10th.

The **Spring 2** session dates will begin the week of April 28 and end the week of June 16. Registration for this session will begin Monday, April 7th.

In order for the program to be launched, the YMCA needs to hire the following staff members **ASAP**:

(1) Adult Site Supervisor – hourly wage: \$15/hour

(4) Swim Lesson Instructors – hourly wage: \$13/hour

(4) Lifeguards – hourly wage: \$13/hour

The Site Supervisor and Instructors will need to be onboarded within the first few weeks of January to ensure training has been completed and all are prepared for the Spring 1 session. Onboard training will be held at the WSY in Camp Hill. Instructors will meet with the WSY Aquatics Director for orientation, will shadow multiple swim instructors at the Y and will also assist with a few classes if deemed necessary.

Here's a possible schedule for youth swimming lessons at Northern to be offered **two days per week, specific days are to be determined:**

Preschool (30 mins)

Beginners: 6pm - 6:30pm, Intermediates: 6:45pm - 7:15pm

Youth (45 mins)

Beginners: 6pm - 6:45pm, Intermediates: 7pm - 7:45pm
