What Is It?

- *Florida Mission of Mercy (FLA-MOM)* is a free, two-day dental clinic hosted by the FDA Foundation.

When Is It?

- Friday and Saturday, March 21 - 22 • Doors open at 7 AM.
- Mainland High School • 1255 W. International Speedway Blvd. • Daytona Beach, FL 32114
- Patients are seen on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Our goal is to treat 2,000 patients in two days, but clinic capacity may be reached quickly, so please come early.

Who Can Receive Treatment?

- Adults willing to wait in line who do not have medically compromising conditions can be treated.
- Photo identification, social security number, insurance information or other personal identification/documentation is **NOT** required.
- Children under the age of 18 can be treated, but they **must** be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Interpreters will be available to assist some languages, but please bring an interpreter if you do not speak English.
- Dress Warmly - clinic may be cold.



What Services Are Provided?

- Exams, cleanings, fillings, extractions, anterior root canals, limited partials and pediatric dentistry.

Sedation And Narcotics Are NOT Available

- If you have dental pain, please do NOT wait to seek care, as this could be a sign of a serious condition.
- If dental pain is severe and accompanied by fever or swelling, go to a hospital emergency room immediately.
