Fulton County Schools is excited to share that we will soon commence our personal safety education program for all elementary students called *Think First & Stay Safe*TM. The *Think First & Stay Safe*TM program is a research-based program that teaches specific personal safety education by way of interactive classroom lessons, classroom posters, role-plays and corresponding activities. *Think First & Stay Safe*TM enables students to take an active and necessary role in protecting themselves from harassment, abduction, bullying, exploitation, and various forms of abuse (physical, sexual, emotional).

In February of this school year, *Think First* & *Stay Safe*™ lessons will be implemented at Shakerag Elementary School for all K-5 students. You may preview this curriculum in the Shakerag Media Center from January 21, 2025, to January 29, 2025.
