Should you move or change information, you need to update your contact information.


In your essay/questions, you need to explain why assistance is needed.

HOW TO APPLY

- Read all instructions.
- Each scholarship has different criteria important to do your homework for each one.
- Read all directions carefully.
- Scholarships that need to be mailed:
 - Complete the Scholarship Cover Sheet and provide to Mrs. Casey (allow 3-4 days before deadline)
- Scholarships with online applications:
 - Provide your school counselor email for transcripts
 - Provide emails of the letters of recommendation writers that you will be using

Please note that letters of recommendation are not provided to students or families and need to be sent directly to the scholarship organization.

Please write a thank you note to the organization! Express your gratitude and appreciation.

Ensure that the organization has your up to date contact information.
