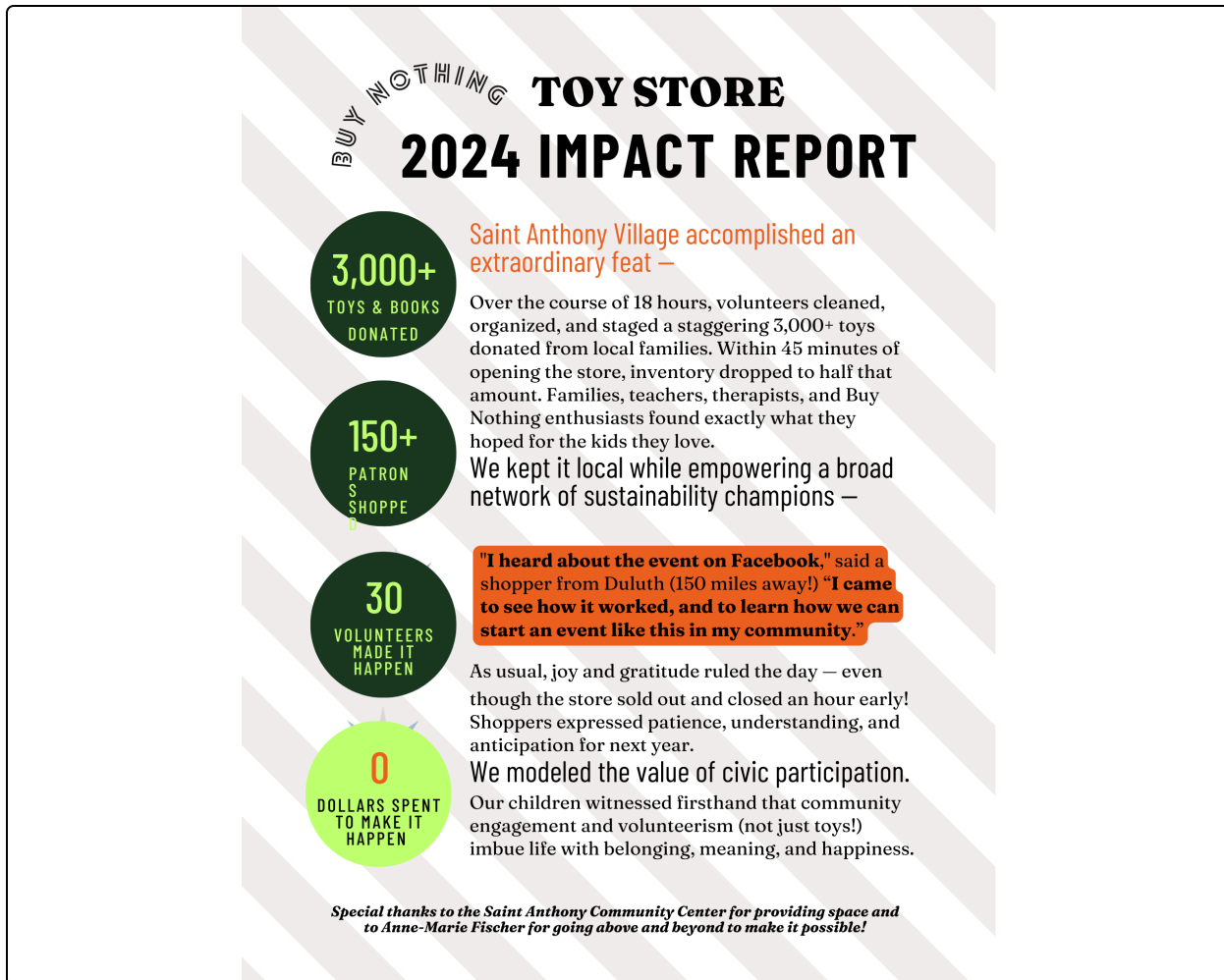

SAVHS Choir Concert TONIGHT!

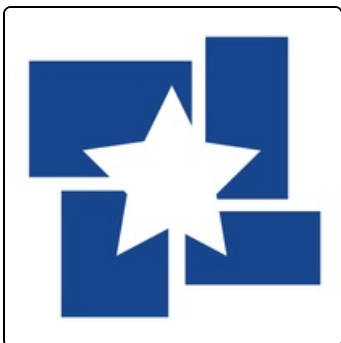
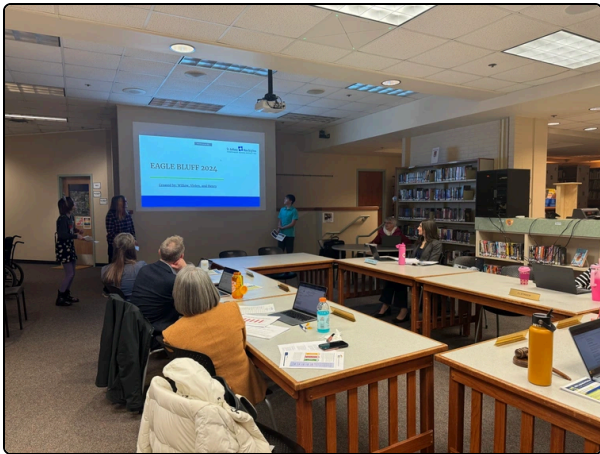

School Board Brief

Dec. 17 Board Brief: Key Takeaways

- Our board members presented the 2025 legislative platform to Minnesota state legislators! Senator Kunesh and Representative Feist got to hear about our district's priorities after sharing their legislative objectives for 2025.
- The board approved the findings of the financial audit for the 2023-2024 fiscal year. The audit (completed by an independent firm) found no issues in our financial records.
- The Human Resources and Q-Comp departments presented mid-year reports to the board.
- 8th graders Willow, Vivien, and Henry shared a report about their Eagle Bluff trip! Eagle Bluff is a year-round environmental learning center focused on education programs and outdoor adventures for children, adults and families.
