

Parking and Pick up - Drop Off

Parents/Guardians & Chauffeur's, we respectfully ask that you not use the staff parking lots (2) on the north side of KMS to drop off or pick up students. There is not enough room in these lots, and they become congested and/or "jammed" very easily. The best spot to pick up or drop off is the bus loop after the buses have gone or on the street (Parkway Dr or Wedgewood Ln).
