# Important Reminders

#### **Arrival & Dismissal**

The safety of our students, staff and families is a top priority during these high-traffic times. Adhering to procedures will help ensure everyone stays safe.

- Please be mindful of any and all pedestrians navigating the parking lot, including students and staff, especially during these busy times
- Please do not park in parking spots designated for staff, in fire lanes, or blocking any parked vehicles
- Please do not leave your vehicle running and unattended anywhere in the parking lot
- Please do not block our school buses from accessing the the entrance/exit of the parking lot



The main office is the heart of our school and a very busy place. We understand that there may be instances, other than illness, when a student is required to leave school early. With a planned early dismissal, please notify your child's teacher and the front office in advance, whenever possible. This can help minimize the time it takes to dismiss your child to you. Additionally, please always have photo ID ready when picking-up your student.

Time spent outdoors can be impacted by the weather, particularly in the winter. We understand the importance of getting in some fresh air and movement each day. Students will go outside for recess every time that temperatures allow. Please make sure your child is wearing seasonally appropriate clothing to school and always has his/her coat or jacket.
