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### Rethinking Status, Identity + Participation in Mathematics

- Partnership with Buffalo State & several districts (Ms sн, A, MV, сн)
- NYS Master Teacher Program, Elementary & MS focus:
  - Disrupting patterns to support students enjoying, excelling and finding relevance in math by exploring structures and socio-math norms so that all students feel the joy and creativity of being a vital math contributor.
  - Teachers come together in classroom labs to engage in professional learning.
  - Anchor readings, new tasks and collaborative learning

### **Transportation Situation**

- 15 Minutes More of Instruction
- Driver Shortage continues at Crisis Levels
- Recommending a change in the structure of runs.

#### Proposal Includes:

- High School and MS to have similar bell schedules
- Grades 6-12 ride the bus together to and from school, on the same run, fill buses
- Runs in this order:
  - High School, Middle School, All Four Elementary Schools on the Same Schedule
- Recommended Walking Radius of .25 Miles for Elementary Buildings



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## Building Use Committee Update



### Potential Benefits of MS Change:

- Middle School students would have more time in the afternoon to participate in extracurricular activities.
- MS students could also be at home in the afternoon to care for their younger siblings.
- More MS teachers could host after-school activities.
- Elementary run as the last run of the day and all on one schedule will help eliminate delays.
- Closer to goal of re-establishing after-school runs to pre-covid levels.
- Eliminate the staggered elementary schedule.
- Little impact on current elementary times.

#### Notes:


- Periods in HS go from 40 to 42 minutes. Same at MS.

- Teacher LOD is 7:15 mins at all schools.

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### **MUSIC FEST IS BACK**


