## Superintendent's Report – Board of Education Meeting – January 22, 2025 - 7:00 p.m.

**Ambitious Instruction** — Classes are academically demanding and engage students by emphasizing the application of knowledge.

- Mid-year NWEA MAP testing is underway with growth and progress reports expected in February
- ACCESS testing has been scheduled for Jan. 27 Feb. 28 for our English Learners
- The 6<sup>th</sup> grade student Candor Health Presentation on Human Reproduction took place on 1/17
- GM student course selection will begin 2/7 and will include a variety of options aimed at maximizing student choice and expanding the student curriculum experience throughout middle school
- In February, 8<sup>th</sup> gr. students are receiving instruction in mental health and depression awareness through P.E. based on programming from Erika's Lighthouse and led by Gower Staff
- The GM Student Council had an opportunity to participate in the Strategic Planning Process by identifying Core Values - There was close alignment with Teacher and Parent groups (e.g. Knowledge, Achievement) Supportive Environment – The school environment is safe, clean and conducive to student learning. Teachers have high expectations for students. Students have the support of their teachers as well as their peers.
  - Year to date attendance: 91.0% (95.0%) for GW K-4 (K-86%; 1st-89%); 95.4% (96.1%) for GM; 95.8% (94.4%) - Teaching Staff and 96.3% (94.8%) for Student Support Staff. Previous year data
  - The Student Council's Hearts at Work fundraising efforts resulted in a \$947 donation to Hesed House
  - Our 8<sup>th</sup> grade students and parents had the opportunity to meet with Hinsdale High School District 86 guidance counselors virtually on Jan. 10<sup>th</sup> to build and review their 9<sup>th</sup> grade schedule
  - The DuPage County ROE Regional Office of Education completed the annual school inspections for both campuses and GW and GM passed with no concerns noted - A standard that we do not take for granted
  - Required staff trainings (Jan. 14 at GM; Jan. 21 at GW) focused on Erin's Law, McKinney-Vento, Domestic and Sexual Violence; Include Teen Dating Violence for GM led by Social Workers

Involved Families and Community – Strong relationships are built across the community to support learning.

- The Core Stakeholder Team made up of nearly 50 members of the Gower School Community will hold their third meeting on 1/21 to continue their work around the Strategic Planning Process
- The annual 5-Essentials Survey is set to open Feb. 18<sup>th</sup>! We have a standing goal of 35% parent participation and encourage all of our families to help us meet it! - Last year; 52% GW, 37% GM (state avg. 19%)
- The District's Annual STEM Night/Science Showcase is scheduled for Jan. 30<sup>th</sup> from 6:00-7:30 pm at GW -This event is open to all families and will feature a live reptile show, STEM activities, and an opportunity to give feedback to our 4th-8th grade Scientists and Engineers
- The Gower PTO continues to support our school community and is hosting a PTO Trivia Night on 2/22
- The Gower Foundation continues to support our school community and is sponsoring the 4th Grade Celebrating Differences Event at GW on 1/29; a popular annual event with a focus on inclusion!

Collaborative Teachers & Staff – The staff is committed to the school, receives strong professional development, & works together to improve.

- The Calendar Committee posted the 2025-26 and 2026-27 school calendars after Board review on Dec. 18<sup>th</sup> for public comment and recommends Board approval at the Jan. 22, 2025 meeting (Appendix A)
- District Committee work continues and most recently involved our Special Education Teams, K-8 Art, District Threat Assessment Team, and GM Math
- Professional Learning on 1/17 was school-based and focused on Assessments/Student Data for general education staff and focused on Accommodations/Modifications for special education staff district-wide
- Each of our regular route and our sub Bus Drivers completed their annual Recertification Course (Jan. 7)
- The district is hosting a professional learning opportunity (1/15) for an after-school screening of the film: Resilience: The Biology of Stress and the Science of Hope with a focus on student trauma and mental health

Effective Leaders – School leaders work with staff to implement a clear and strategic vision for school success.

- The 8th Annual High School Transition Survey was administered to D86 9th grade students on Jan. 8-10 -This area-wide survey is implemented by D86 and led by Gower School District - results forthcoming
- After the ISBE ELL Audit (1/21) and CKH implementation visit (1/22), the Gower Admin Team will finalize requirements to meet all probes for the upcoming ROE Compliance Audit (2/6)
- The administrative review process of the curriculum design, organization of instruction, and class size is underway for 2025-26 staffing and program recommendations expected in March/April
- Efforts to expand relationships with university programs and potential candidates continue; e.g. Student Teachers each semester, Student Services interns with plans for a School Psychologist intern for 2025-26
