Scholarship available for graduating seniors of Garland ISD who have excelled in the bilingual studies/ESL program

The **Elizabeth Anne Ala Scholarship** awards one scholarship of up to \$2,000 to a graduating senior of any high school in Garland ISD in the state of Texas that has participated and excelled in the bilingual studies/ESL program. The scholarship may be used for tuition, fees and books at any accredited college or university in the United States or its possessions.

Applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale and have achieved a 3.5 or greater cumulative GPA in all bilingual/ESL classes. Applicants must be U.S. Citizens or documented legal residents of the United States.

Selection criteria include academic excellence in bilingual studies, school and community participation, demonstrated leadership potential, essay response, letters of recommendation and financial need.

All applicants must submit a short essay and two letters of recommendation and complete the FAFSA.
