



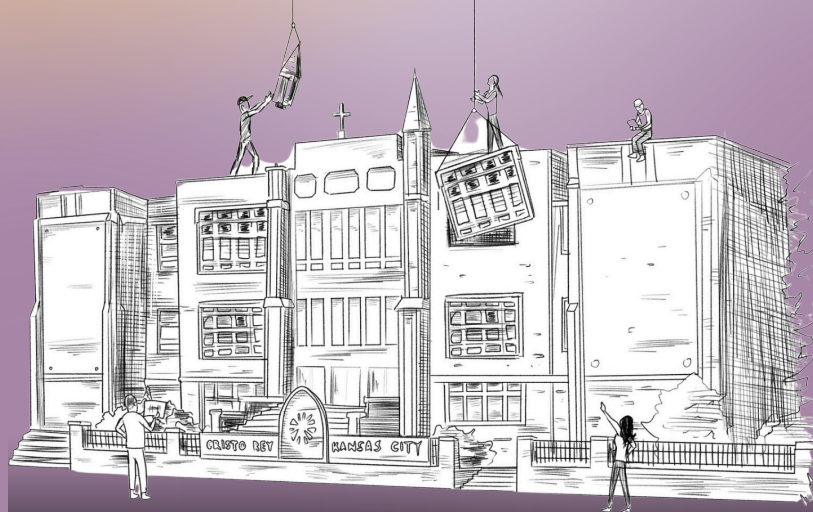

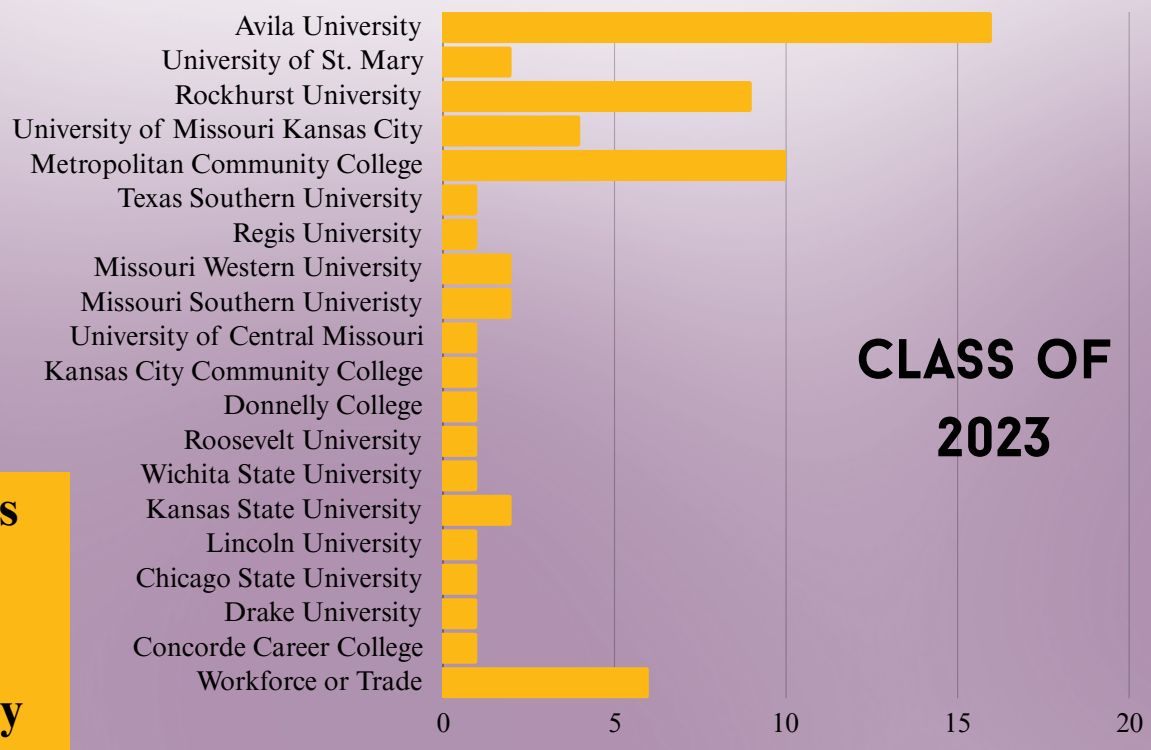
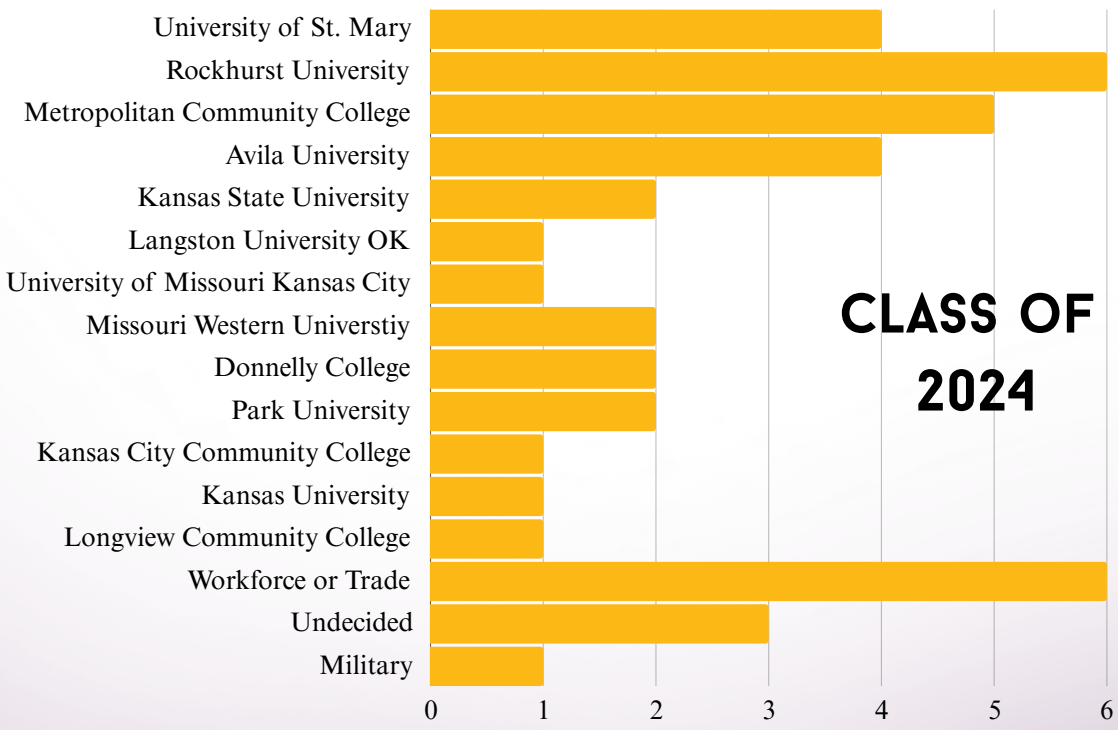


## **Joseph Hernandez: Class of 2016**

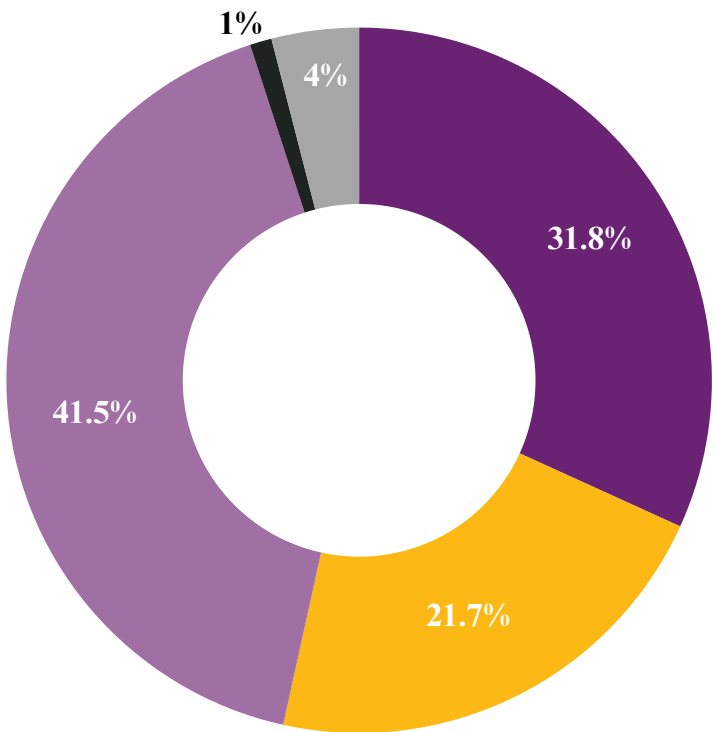

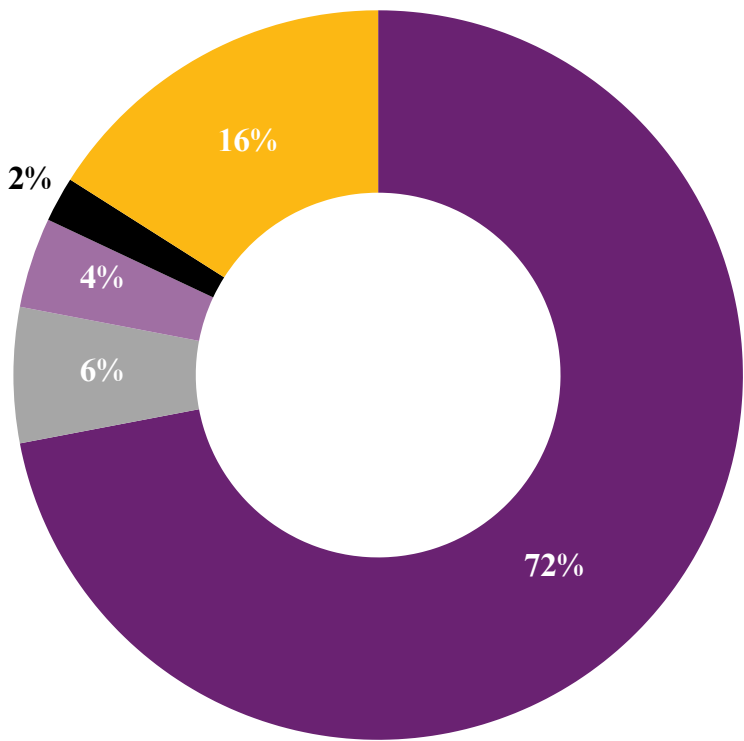
