Security Upgrades

- Honeywell Intrusion
 - 90% of systems upgraded
- Fire Alarm System
 - 40% of systems upgraded
- Video Surveillance
 - replacing 3,219 Cameras 2023
- Remote Entry (Open Options)
 - 95% of systems upgraded
- Lightning Prediction System
 - Upgrading 11 systems
