Ms. Lee provided an overview of safe and secure schools, climate and culture, wellness services, inclement weather services, and health services. Ms. Lee and Ms. Duecker answered questions from the committee meetings regarding school safety.

Mr. Shaw introduced Wayman Tisdale Elementary principal, Ms. Erika Davis. Ms. Davis welcomed the committee members to the school. Ms. Davis shared her appreciation of bond dollars and the improvements made at the school.

Ms. Duecker introduced Mike Wozniak from the Bike Club. Mr. Wozniak gave the committee an overview of the Bike Club's work throughout the district. He shared that the program is offered in 34 of Tulsa Public Schoos. He shared that the bike club has been offered at Tulsa Public Schools for over 10 years. Mr. Wozniak answered questions from committee members.

Mr. Shaw thanked the guests for presenting at the meeting.

Mr. Shaw made a motion to adjourn the meeting, the motion was made, seconded, and passed unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 1:05 p.m.
