

### Safety & Security: Access Door Controls

Security Project Defined: The 2021 Bond included \$1.5MM in unassigned funds for safety and security projects as they became needed. (in addition to multiple other safety projects)


- The district *Safety & Security Team* prioritized the need for additional "card access" controlled entrances near school playgrounds and parking lots.
- Bond funds will be used to add additional door swipes where needed, typically 2 per site.
- School visits are in progress to identify most needed entrances.
- Construction is underway. This is a 12 month project, touching every school.

(Supply chain challenges delayed the start of installations until this March.)

### Exterior LED Lighting: Progress

Replaces all old yellow mercury vapor lights with new LED

- <u>Doubling</u> light output in exterior parking lots
- PSO replacing all existing lights at no cost to district.
- Lights leased from PSO, who will maintain/repair
- TPS, through bond, will add additional lights where needed.




