

Dear Representative / Senator _____ ,

My name is XXXX XXXXXX and I have been a resident of the Granville school district since XXXX.

M/I Homes is in the process of developing land to build over 500 homes in Union Township/Heath. The increase in the number of students that Granville will have to educate will cause the district's buildings to become severely overcrowded and will require the district to eventually build new buildings and add on to existing buildings.

The state's investment in Intel's massive campus a short drive away in New Albany is creating additional demands for affordable housing. However, the new M/I homes will start in the low \$500,000 range and run all the way up to \$1 million homes, which are not affordable for most Ohioans. A large part of the reason M/I can charge these prices is because of the project's location in the Granville Exempted Village School District.

The residents of the Granville school district need your help in a couple of ways. First, we need additional state resources to help construct new buildings and expand current buildings. If the state has the financial resources to support Intel building here, it also has an obligation to help local governmental entities adjust to the population influx we are going to see in the near future. Second, we need you to support legislation to require school district boundaries to move with an annexation in cases where a city annexes land in an unincorporated area for residential construction. This is a needed change in statute to prevent Granville school district from being overrun by development and annexation from Heath and Newark.

Thank you for your service and your representation of our district. As a constituent, I am confident you will help us deal with the changes to our schools being forced upon us by other local governments.
