

2025-2026 Kindergarten and Alternative Kindergarten Registration

Kindergarten and Alternative Kindergarten Registration for the 2025-2026 school year will begin on Monday, February 3, 2025, at approximately 9:00 AM.

If your child will turn 5 years old by September 30, 2025, your child is eligible for Kindergarten. If your child will turn 5 years old between May 1, 2025 - September 30, 2025, your child is eligible for Alternative Kindergarten.
