Our Preschool and PreK programs are part of Eden Prairie Schools Community Education and provide innovative classrooms where creativity and imagination soar! There are many preschool options available to families in Eden Prairie, yet our programs are the only ones that align with Eden Prairie Schools K-12 curriculum and the overall K-12 system. We work closely with Early Childhood Special Education and kindergarten teachers to foster a successful transition from preschool to kindergarten. In our 4-year-old PreK programming, we offer additional child care opportunities, transportation, and longer instructional time!

Curriculum Focused on Personalized Learning

In Eden Prairie Schools, our mission is to inspire each student every day. Our programming is designed to create excitement around education and provide a foundation for lifelong learning. We use The Creative Curriculum, which is a balanced approach of all social-emotional and academic areas. We focus on personalized learning for your child, which means our teachers design lessons around your child's skills to prepare them for kindergarten and beyond. Throughout the school year, staff conduct assessments of your child's academic, social and emotional progress using the Teaching Strategies GOLD observation-based assessment tool.

LOCATION

TRANSPORTATION FOR 3 YEAR OLDS

Only 3-year-olds who meet certain eligibility requirements will qualify for transportation. Questions about transportation? Visit our website for more information.

CAN I ENROLL MY CHILD IN MORE THAN ONE PRESCHOOL

SECTION? No, your child can only be enrolled in one preschool section.

DO YOU HAVE CHILD CARE ON DAYS THERE IS NO SCHOOL?

Preschool does not have child care on days the district does not have school.

DOES MY CHILD NEED TO BE TOILET INDEPENDENT?

Children should be toilet independent or must be actively toilet training before entering preschool, meaning they have:

- the ability to identify and verbalize the urge to use the restroom in a timely manner
- the ability to manage all self-help/toileting skills independently
- the ability to manage their preschool day including rest time without a pull-up/diaper

We are aware that it is developmentally appropriate for children of this age to have accidents from time to time. In the event that your child needs additional support through toilet training, staff will work with you and your child. Parent Educators are available to support parents with any questions.

4-YEAR-OLD PREK

MUST BE FOUR YEARS OLD BY SEPT. 1, 2025

Create a school community connection, reduce transitions and prepare your child for kindergarten through 4 year old PreK at one of our five neighborhood elementary schools. Through interactive, stimulating and academically rich instruction, your child will practice academic, social and emotional skills to prepare for kindergarten. Breakfast or lunch mealtimes are included. If your family lives within the Eden Prairie Schools district boundaries and you choose to attend your neighborhood school for PreK, transportation is provided.

JUNIOR EAGLE ZONE

Junior Eagle Zone child care is a choice-based program that allows children to take the lead in their learning journey. From imaginative play areas to hands-on arts and crafts, our curriculum encourages self-expression and independent play.

Our Eagle Zone staff are highly trained and are dedicated to guiding children as they discover their passions and make new friends. If your child is enrolled in Junior Eagle Zone, they will experience a fun and enriching environment where every day is an opportunity for exploration and growth.

Where to Enroll

Families must sign up for Junior Eagle Zone through your online account portal at <u>edenprairie.ce.eleyo.com</u>.

To enroll in Junior Eagle Zone, you must select the days and site location that align with your PreK schedule. For example, if your student is in 4-day Mon.–Thurs. PreK at Eden Lake, you will sign up for 4-day Mon.–Thurs. Junior Eagle Zone at Eden Lake.

Enrollment Process & Fees

Families must enroll in a 4 or 5 day Junior Eagle Zone schedule that aligns with their student's PreK schedule.

Auto payments are due by the 15th of each month following care provided.

A non-refundable registration fee is required for each student enrolling in the program. The registration fee is charged once the contract is accepted.

One-time registration fee for the 2025-26 school year:

- January 20–February 20, 2025: Fee waived
- February 21–June 10, 2025: \$75/student non-refundable fee
- After June 10, 2025: \$100/student non-refundable fee

LOCATIONS/NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOLS

4 year old preschool programming is offered at our five neighborhood elementary schools. Eagle Heights Spanish Immersion does not offer PreK.

Can my child attend a school other than their neighborhood

school? We encourage families to attend their neighborhood school for PreK, since that best prepares your child for kindergarten! Busing is not provided if a family attends a school that is not their neighborhood school. (Please note: If you do choose to have your child attend a different school than their neighborhood school for PreK, that does not mean your child will be approved to attend kindergarten at that school. Kindergarten enrollments in non-neighborhood schools are approved on a case-by-case basis.)

Our older child attends Eagle Heights Spanish Immersion, now what? Proof of a sibling attending Eagle Heights is required to enroll in Oak Point if it is not the boundary school for the family.

Can I open enroll from another district?

Residents of surrounding communities are welcome to enroll their child. Contracts will be accepted based on availability of space and transportation is not available.

TRANSPORTATION FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS

Students ride the regular bus route with students enrolled in K-5 within the Eden Prairie Schools district boundary. The transportation department will send parents information regarding the bus stop location.

- PreK students ride in the front of the bus in dedicated seats.
- Students will have access to transportation before and after their PreK class.
- Students must be supervised by a parent/guardian at the bus stop until they are safely on the bus.
- Students must be met at the bus stop by a parent/guardian to be released from the bus.

My child is enrolled in Junior Eagle Zone after morning PreK, will my child have transportation at the end of the school day? Yes, children will be able to ride the PreK-5 bus home at the end of the elementary school day.

Does my child qualify for busing? Busing is provided to 4-year-old students who attend their boundary school.

MEALS

PreK students will have breakfast or lunch as a part of their day. Morning PreK includes breakfast and afternoon PreK includes lunch. Families have the option of sending breakfast or lunch with their child. All school meals are FREF.

If your child is attending Junior Eagle Zone, they will have access to school lunch or families may provide lunch in addition to breakfast in the morning.

The Adult English classes are provided by Metro South Adult Basic Education from 9:45 a.m. –12:00 p.m. Mondays and Wednesdays or Tuesdays and Thursdays, depending on class level. Prior to starting participants will take an online comprehension reading exam. Registration for 2025-26 Family School will open Summer of 2025 and testing will begin at that time too.

EARLY CHILDHOOD SPECIAL EDUCATION

Eden Prairie Schools Community Education works with children of all abilities. Our staff work with enrolled families to provide reasonable accommodations as needed for each child. The goal for all children is to have independent, meaningful participation in the program.

All children participating in programming must consistently demonstrate the ability to follow adult directions, show readiness for large group activities, including the ability to remain with the group, and follow safety rules.

Children need to meet state eligibility criteria in order to receive Early Childhood Special Education services. Questions and concerns regarding your child's development are welcomed. For additional information, contact our Early Childhood Special Education Lead at 952-975-7138.

Have you scheduled your child's Early Childhood Screening? Make an Appointment TODAY!

Join us at Early Childhood Screening as soon as your child turns 3!

This is a FREE and simple check of how your child is growing and developing.

It is a requirement of the State of Minnesota for all 3-5 year olds.

WHAT AGE SHOULD MY CHILD BE SCREENED?

Screening is best completed at age 3, yet can be completed at 4 or 5. The earlier, the better! If your child will be starting Preschool/PreK or Kindergarten in the fall, or if you have a concern about your child's development, please make an appointment for Early Childhood Screening.

WHERE IS SCREENING HELD?

Screening appointments are held in the Welcome Center at 8100 School Road, Eden Prairie. Enter at the Welcome Center entrance, door #1, and they will direct you where to go.

WHAT DATES ARE SCREENING APPOINTMENTS CURRENTLY AVAILABLE?

WHAT INFORMATION IS GATHERED AT SCREENING?

Screening questions are tailored specifically to your child's age. Discover more about your child's development and learning, such as:

- Cognitive, language, and communication skills
- Social and emotional development
- Large and small muscle coordination
- Height, weight, hearing, and vision

Early Childhood Screening is one way to support children in their early years of growth and development. It is also a way to identify children who may benefit from early childhood special services before they enter school and connect families with the appropriate resources and programs.

WHAT DOES SCREENING COST?


Early Childhood Screening is FREE! During screening, each child also receives a free book.

REGISTRATION FAQS

PRESCHOOL/PREK REGISTRATION FEE

January 20–February 20, 2025: Fee waived February 20–June 10, 2025: \$75 non-refundable fee After June 10, 2025: \$100 non-refundable fee

Payment for September is charged on August 15th; the remaining eight payments are charged on the first day of the month from October through May (includes June payment).

BIRTH DATE REQUIREMENTS

For both Preschool and PreK, please select classes based on your child's age by Sept. 1, 2025. This age requirement aligns with district and state kindergarten age requirements.

BIRTH CERTIFICATE

A copy of your child's birth certificate is required for any child participating in any Early Childhood Education programing including Preschool/PreK. A copy is required in the online registration process before enrollment.

IMMUNIZATION LAW

All students in Minnesota must have immunizations up-to-date and on record with the school before the child starts class. A record of immunizations is required in the online registration process before enrollment.

CANCELLATION POLICY FOR PRESCHOOL

Any changes to the child's schedule, including withdrawal from the program, notice must be given 10 business days prior to when the change is needed. Please contact the Early Childhood Office at 952-975-7200 or EPS_LittleEagles@edenpr.org. If notice is not given, two weeks of tuition will be charged to the account. A \$20 processing fee is charged for all cancellations and classroom changes. No refunds are given for emergency or weather closings or for days missed due to illness or vacation. Please note registration fees are non-refundable.

FEE ASSISTANCE FOR PRESCHOOL/PREK

Limited tuition assistance is provided for qualifying families. To determine eligibility for assistance, families select factors that apply to their family situation during the registration process. Income will be verified to determine eligibility.
