The District

Pittsford Central School District is a nationally ranked school district. An average of 93 percent of the Pittsford graduating seniors are college bound. SAT and ACT scores of Pittsford School students far exceed those on the state and national level (PCSD: 1,264 Composite SAT, 27.1 Composite ACT). Pittsford students perform consistently above state standards on New York State Standards Tests.

Ninety-nine percent of Pittsford students graduate with a college preparatory Regents Diploma. Of these students, 46 percent earn a Regents Diploma with advanced designation and 30 percent earn a Regents Diploma with advanced designation with honors.

Pittsford students take more than 2,200 Advanced Placement tests in 30 courses with an average score of 4.0.

Staff/student ratio is maintained at a low level for individual achievement by students, mastery of basic skills, and preparation for lifelong learning. School counselors, learning specialists, school nurses, speech and language pathologists and school psychologists are available in each Pittsford school.

Our schools include an array of instructional programs to meet the needs of all types of learners. Not only are our students engaged in high quality learning in the core areas of English Language Arts, mathematics, and science, we provide opportunities for experiences in encore areas such as the arts, music, physical education, career and technical education, technology and other specialized elective courses. In addition, students may participate in any number of extracurricular activities, such as musical productions, athletics, or a vast number of special interest clubs.

A key factor in the ability of Pittsford Schools to provide a quality education for students is the strong support and interest in the community for the best possible education for youth. School district residents support education by serving on school committees, volunteering time in the schools, and serving as resources to the schools as speakers, consultants and assistants. The excellence in district program and facilities is directly linked to a supportive community and a close school/community partnership.



The Community

Pittsford is a residential, suburban community located a few miles southeast of Rochester in Upstate New York. Pittsford is known for its picturesque village, beautiful neighborhoods, spacious parks and quiet, suburban setting. The Village of Pittsford is also on the scenic Erie Canal. Many shops and restaurants line the banks of this historic site. The attractive surroundings, proximity to the city of Rochester, and excellent schools have made Pittsford a desirable residential area for business and professional people.

The Rochester metropolitan area is a high technology industrial community. Rochester is home to several major companies including Xerox, Wegmans, Kodak and Paychex. The Greater Rochester Region is bordered by Lake Ontario and the Finger Lakes. Museums, art galleries, theater, dance, opera and the noted Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra offer a wide variety of cultural programs. Residents enjoy local, national and international performances at The Auditorium Theatre and Geva Theatre, and the region is host to events such as Rochester International Jazz, Fringe, Film, and Lilac Festivals. Some of the best public and private educational institutions in the country are here, including the University of Rochester and its Eastman School of Music, and the Rochester Institute of Technology.

The metropolitan area also boasts nearly 11,000 acres of tennis courts, baseball diamonds, skating rinks, golf courses, bridle paths, swimming pools, hiking paths and ski runs. There are water sports and fishing in nearby lakes and streams. The area offers easy access to the nearby Finger Lakes Region, Thousand Islands, Adirondack Mountains, Niagara Falls and Toronto, Canada.
