The students also get to participate in clubs. The hope is to expand this program at Fain and throughout the district. Ms. Crawford encouraged the other members of SHAC to check out the program and get involved. The idea is to expand the program at Fain by training the now 4th grade to be mentors to 1st graders when they get in 5th grade next year.
