- 1. Call to order (S. Batra)
 - a. The meeting was called to order at 4:30pm by Shiven Batra. All members were present.

- a. There was no one from the public at this meeting.
- 3. Approvals of the September 17, 2024 Minutes (S. Batra)
 - a. Shiven Batra motioned to approve the September minutes. Elizabeth Henderson seconded the motion. There was unanimous approval of the September 17, 2024 minutes.
- 4. Course Review (G. Sloan)
 - a. Existing RJUHSD Courses
 - b. New RIUHSD Courses
 - c. Mr. Sloan explained the process of reviewing the courses in the above links. Site Council reviews, asks questions, provides feedback, etc., but we do not vote on these courses.
 - d. Mr. Sloan reviewed his list of the courses in the documents that are offered at Granite Bay.
 - e. The 9-week Ethnic Studies course will be required next year for 9th graders. This class will be combined with a 9-week Health class. Each class will be worth 5 credits. Staffing will be impacted, but Mr. Sloan has a plan. There are different credentials needed for each course. Students will switch at the quarter. Both Health & Ethnic Studies have been revised to fit the new 9-week term.
 - f. It was asked if we were required to cut Health. Health is not a state requirement for students. Health must be offered at a school but the state does not require it as a graduation requirement. Our district does require it as a graduation requirement.
 - g. It was noted that there are existing courses in the documents that are missing course IDs.
 - h. It was noted that Creative Writing doesn't have any textbooks or supplemental texts listed. Mr. Sloan advised that this class was taught at Roseville High School.
- 5. Principal's Report (G. Sloan)
 - a. The quarter ended on Friday. Grades will roll over tomorrow.

- b. Fall sports, the Choir Concert and the fall play are coming. We are in full swing with activities on campus.
- c. Data is starting to be released. Our Math data increased this year. Overall, our data looks good. Mr. Sloan will share when everything is updated.
