Superintendent's Report: *Timestamp 25:00 - 40:25* Dr. Andrew Pulver

During his presentation, Dr. Pulver spoke about the following:

- Rossmoor Lockdown Debrief: Dr. Pulver spoke about the incident, highlighting that on Thursday, December 19, shortly before 2:00 p.m., an individual rang the bell at the Rossmoor Elementary preschool gate and claimed there was an active shooter. Our staff immediately contacted 911, and out of an abundance of caution, Rossmoor and the three other Rossmoor area schools were also briefly placed on lockdown. At no point was the individual ever on our school campus. The transient individual was apprehended by OC Sheriffs and was taken to a local hospital for help.
- Supporting Victims and Communities Affected by the Los Angeles Area Fires: Dr. Pulver highlighted the incredible giving spirit of our community to help those in need and the various ways our schools are helping to support victims of the fires including a donation drive that was held on Sunday, January 12, resulting in four 26-ft UHaul trucks being filled with goods to help families in need.
