Welcome back! I hope everyone had a relaxing winter break. We started this week strong with a wonderful discussion about goals. First, we thought about achievements that were made in 2024 and attainable goals for 2025. Ask your student about their goals for 2025 and how they plan to achieve them.

The weather held out long enough for us to have a peaceful walk to the outdoor classroom and learn about the different leaves and trees on the trails.


