Students and Staff celebrated Unity Day on Oct. 16 by wearing orange and creating Kindness posters.

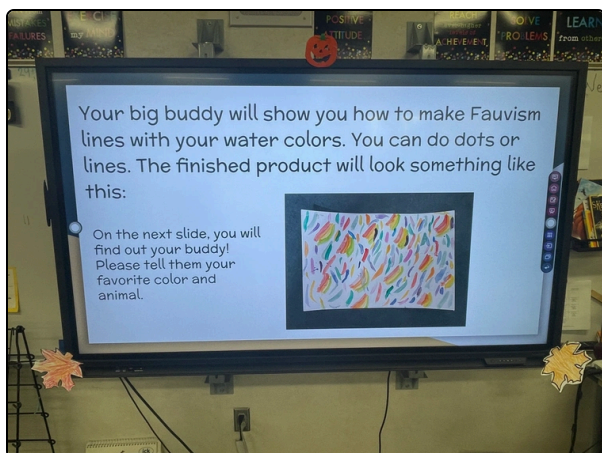
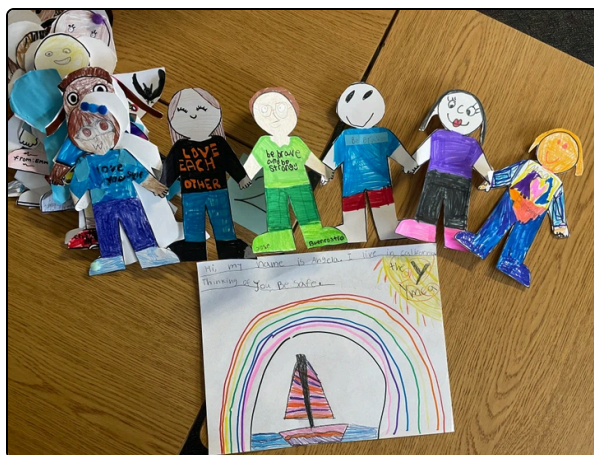
Spirit week included a day for students to participate in a Kindness scavenger hunt.

Students in the Find My Genius after school program made kind messages to those affected by the recent hurricanes.



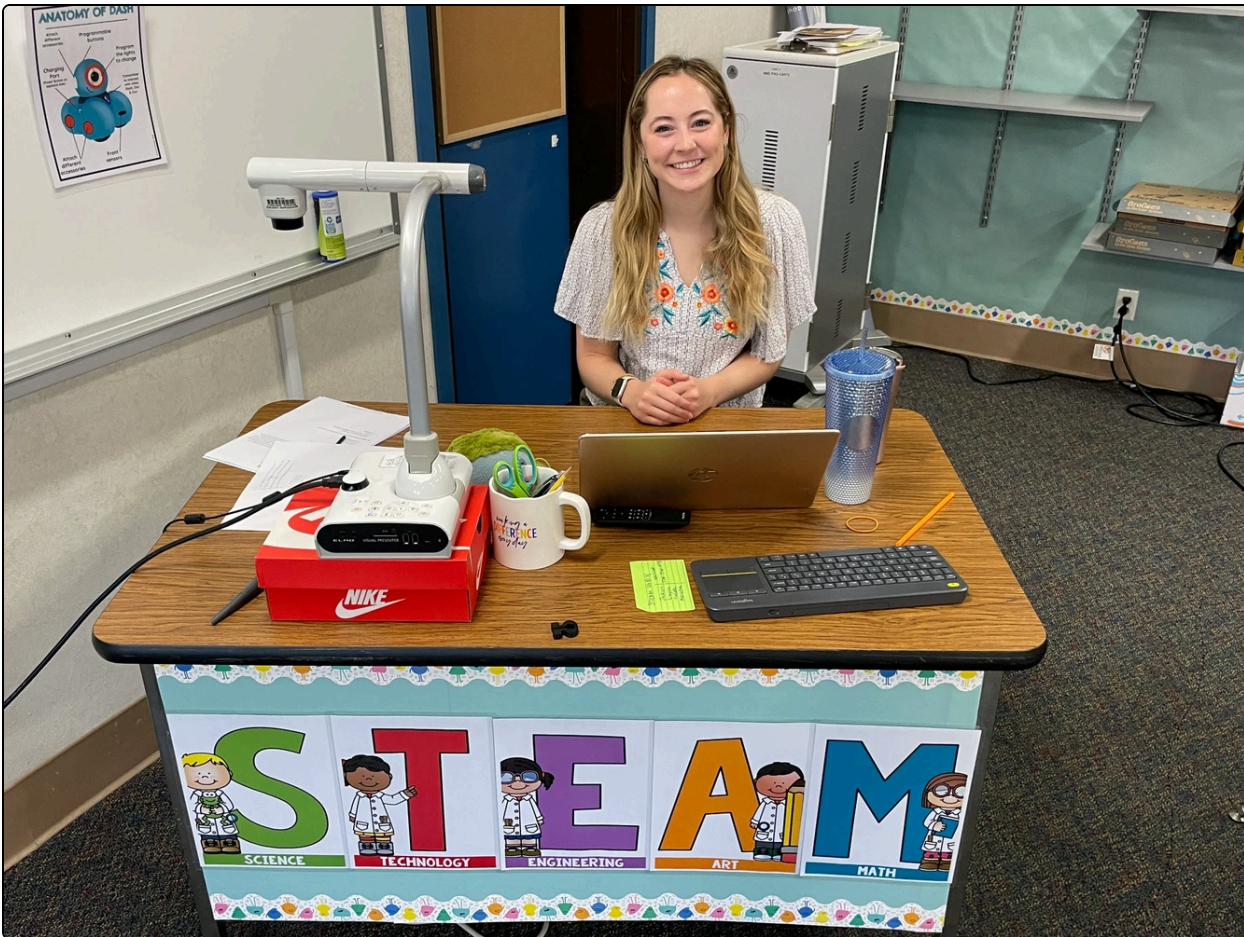


Day Of Awesomeness!!!

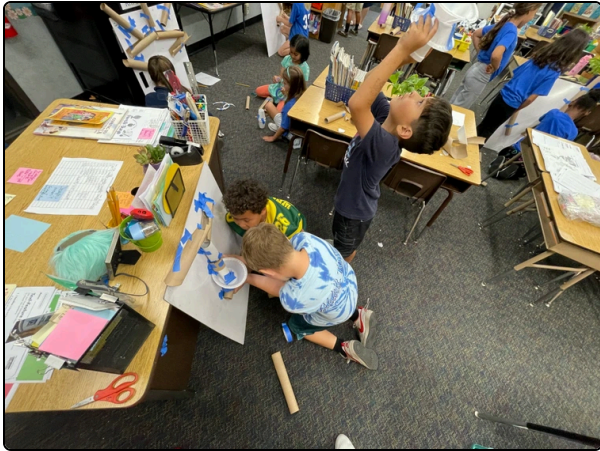
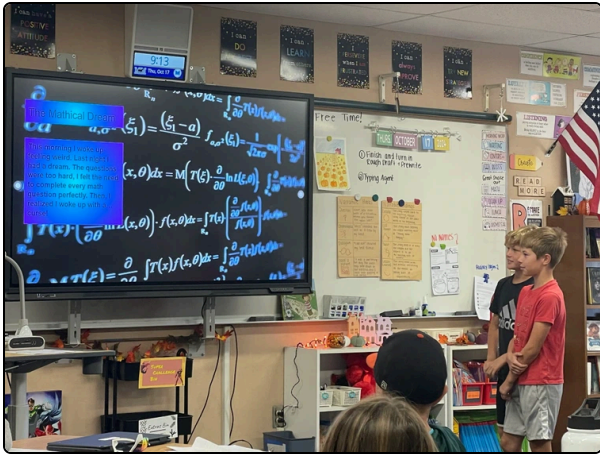
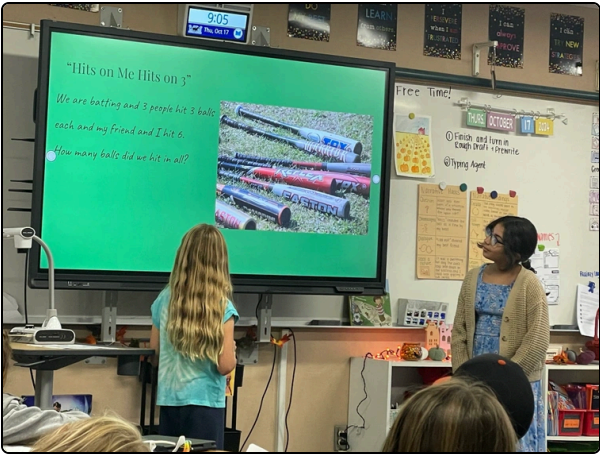


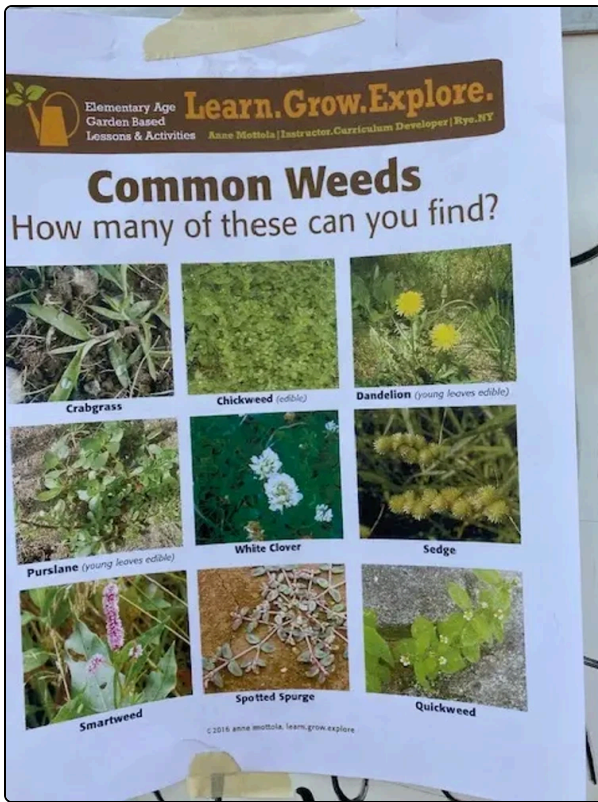
MM Students Love to Learn!

- Teaching and Learning Garden



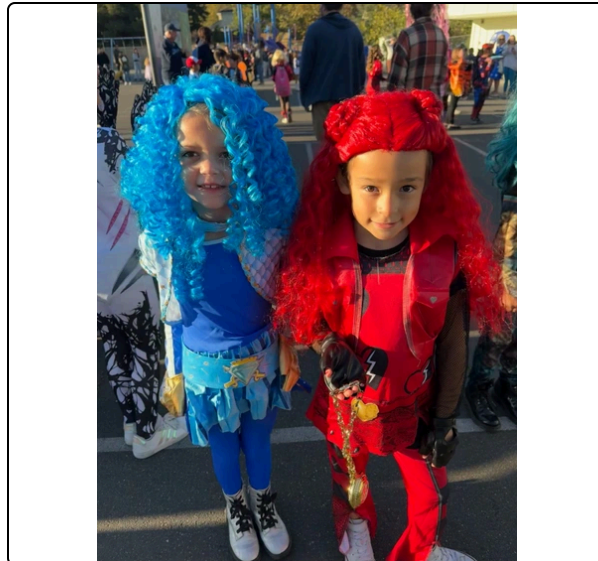


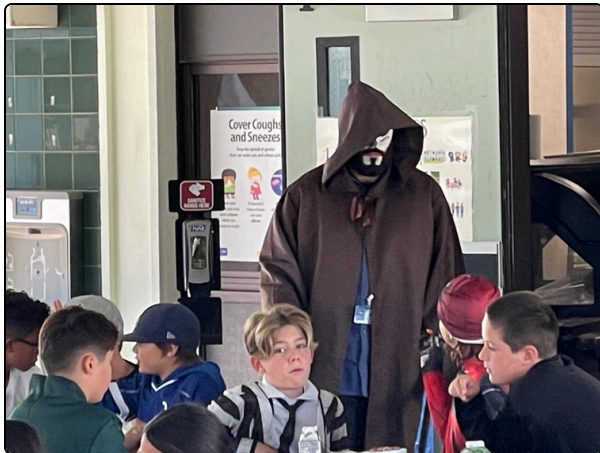
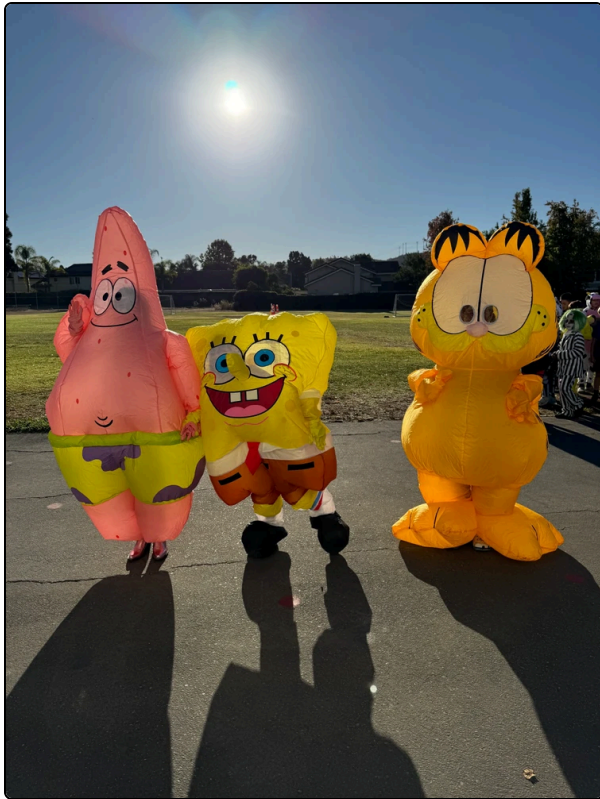




MM finished October In Style

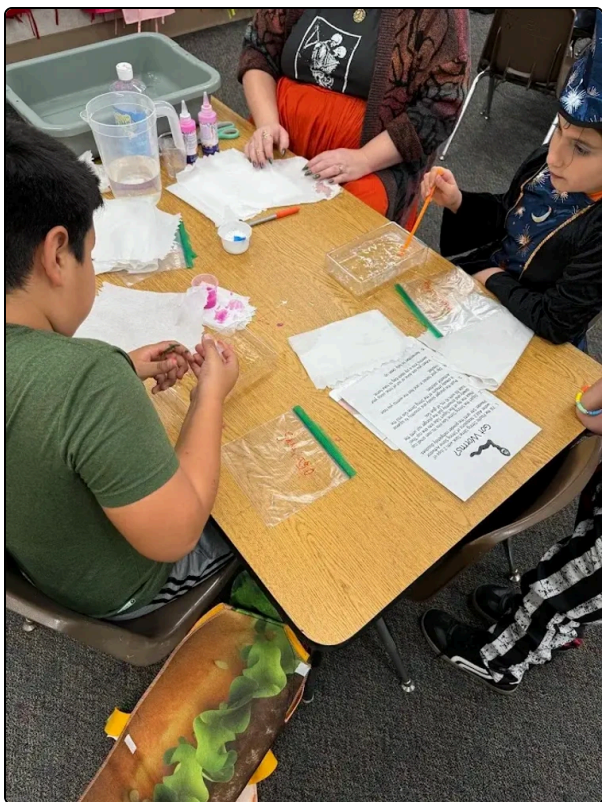












Important Reminders
