Who is Eligible for RCPI Program?

The Refugee Career Pathways Initiative (RCPI) program helps refugees, asylees, Iraqi and Afghan Special Immigrant Visa (SIV) Holders (SI or SQ), non-U.S. Citizens, Afghan Humanitarian Parolees/Ukrainian humanitarian parolees, who arrived under specific circumstance during a defined period, to achieve self-sufficiency by obtaining credentials, education, experience, and job skills to secure employment in professional and skilled careers.

What are the Services Provided by RCPI Program?

We assist our participants with customized career pathways and consultations, Translate and evaluate their credentials, and provide job search assistance. In addition, we assist our participants with applying for Federal financial aid and help pay for books.

What Is the Cost of RCPI program?

Our service is free of charge! The federal Office of Refugee Resettlement funds the Refugee Career Pathways Program.
