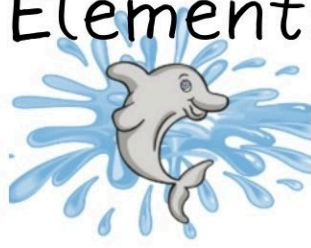

All students will complete mid-year VALLS during the month of January. In addition, 1st and 2nd grade students will complete the Math MAP assessment. Teachers will share these results with you at parent teacher conferences in February.
