CCPS Winter Weather Alert for Tuesday, January 21, 2025

Schools will be closed; Virtual working and learning day.

JONESBORO - The leadership of Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS) has been intently monitoring the potential development of wintry weather that has been forecasted for Clayton County and Metro Atlanta through reports from the National Weather Service, regional media outlets, and Clayton County Emergency Management Agency's Office of Resilience and Sustainability.

As a result, CCPS leadership has decided to pivot to a virtual working day for staff and an asynchronous learning day for students on Tuesday, January 21, 2025. This means staff should be accessible via phone call, email, or virtual meeting requests. Students will be engaged in independent virtual learning. All members of the district's Facilities Services (Maintenance) Department are being asked to report to work on Tuesday, January 21st to check all school buildings and district facilities to determine if the evening's extremely low temperatures cause any issues.

All athletic and extracurricular events and school system-related programs for Tuesday, January 21, 2025, have been canceled and may be rescheduled for a later date. Families with children enrolled in the Campus Kids Program will receive a refund for each day of inclement weather. No action is required. Refunds are expected to be processed within 2-3 business days.

Special Note: District leadership will continue to closely monitor weather conditions throughout the week and will report to staff, students, and their families the status of school following Tuesday, January 21, 2025.
