Safety Town is a program designed to teach children residing in Oakland and entering Kindergarten in September (5 years old on or before October 1, 2025) different strategies about safety at home and in their community.

During this program, children learn safe behavior through their own involvement. They do this by roleplaying in simulated and actual life situations under the guidance of teachers, a police officer and student volunteers. Safety songs, art projects, stories, movies and visits with Police and Fire Departments and the First Aid Squad make this program a fun learning experience that children eagerly look forward to attending.

There will be Two Sessions per Day:

Group #1 8:45 a.m. to 10:15 a.m. Group #2 10:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

There will be a maximum enrollment of 50 children in each section **If minimum enrollment is not reached, sessions will be combined.**
