COVID-19 Site Measures Reminders

- **Objective:**

To keep all students, faculty, staff, and visitors safe while on campus in compliance with developing standards from the Santa Clara County Department of Public Health.

- **Board-Approved Policies:**

(1) Site Measures; (2) Facemask Policy (Revised); (3) Social Distancing Protocol; and (4) COVID Response (Injury Illness and Prevention Addendum). Students and staff that are sick or COVID Positive must remain home for further steps.

- **Personal Protective Equipment:**

(1) COVID At-Home ADA Rapid Antigen; (2) N95 Masks; (3) Sneeze Guards (As-Requested); and (4) Hand Sanitizer..

Note: Temperature no longer required per SCC DPH.

Protocol and Measures Taken Daily - TFHE Sites

- Any 'symptomatic' site occupants are sent home (with parent/guardian pick-up for students).
- All must receive a 'Negative' Antigen At-Home COVID Test, certify no symptoms, and be cleared by Compliance and the School Site prior to return.
- Positive student or staff cases go through the following steps:
 - Required isolation
 - Contact Tracing Exercise
 - Reporting to the County
 - Public Letter to All School Stakeholders
 - Next steps and clearance prior to return.
- Sterilization continues to take place at all sites.
- Designated isolation spaces are no longer part of daily site measures.



Key COVID-19 Information for Reference

- **Pick-Up of COVID-19 Tests and PPE:**

Please stop by Room 105 at LCPA or your school Main Office.
Sneeze guards in classrooms are available upon request.

- **Regular Testing and Boosters Recommended:**

Recommended Cadence of Every Two Weeks for Testing and as advised by Healthcare Provider for Boosters.

- **Guidance for Use of Masks in School Sites:**

Masks are recommended, but no longer required by fully vaccinated individuals. Close contacts are also advised to wear masks on site.

- **All School Events Will Be Reinstated As Long As Approved by School Site Administrators.**

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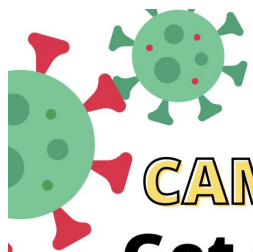
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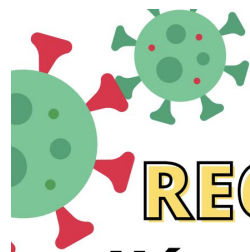
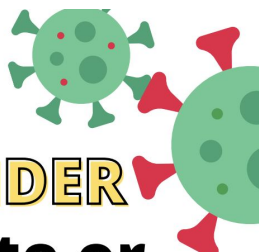

TK-12 COVID-19 Mitigations Strategies

Framework	Individual-Based Tracing	Group-Based Tracing
Students with COVID-19	Isolate per general CDPH recommendations	Isolate per general CDPH recommendations
Students exposed to someone with COVID-19	Identify <u>individuals</u> (close contacts) who were within 6 feet of someone with COVID-19 for at least 15 mins within 24 hours	Identify <u>groups</u> who shared the same indoor airspace with someone with COVID-19 for at least 15 mins within 24 hours
What kind of notifications are sent?	<u>Individual</u> notifications to only the individuals identified as close contacts to the COVID-19 case	Group notification to <u>all members of the group</u> (i.e., whole class, sports team) as above
Which students may quarantine at school? Which students quarantine at home?	<p>Depends on vaccination status, prior infection and/or symptoms</p> <p><u>No symptoms:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Up-to-date/prior infection = no quarantine <u>Not</u> fully vaccinated/up-to-date = Modified Quarantine <p><u>Symptoms and negative test:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Standard Quarantine 	<p>Regardless of vaccination status or prior infection</p> <p><u>No symptoms:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remain in school <p><u>Symptoms:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Isolate at home; test immediately and follow decision tree as usual
Testing (school-based or non-school-based)	All identified <u>individuals</u> , with timing dependent on quarantine category (3-5 days vs. 5 or later)	<u>Entire group</u> tests on Day 3-5 from exposure
