San Mateo-Foster City EdFund Read-a-thon:



We're excited to begin the Education Foundation's 9th annual Readathon from January 24th to February 7th. ALL SMFCSD preschool – 8th graders may participate. Our goal this year is for SMFCSD students to read 2 million minutes and raise \$140,000 to support essential staff and programs across our district, like LEGO Education Labs and middle school clubs.

We encourage each school to increase their total reading minutes and fundraising by 20% compared to what they accomplished last year. The 2025 goals for Fiesta Gardens are \$6,000 and to read 57,000 minutes! We know you can do it!

Thank you for your partnership in making this year's Readathon a success. In addition, our students will be participating in an activity at school where they will mark the square on the sheet below and complete a path of 4 in a row to score points.

Below are the options and timelines for current FGIS 5th graders in the process for 6th grade next year 2025/2026.

- Choose to remain at FGIS for 6th grade*
- Enroll in your assigned neighborhood school*
- Choose to submit a transfer to 6th grade at Abbott (non-immersion program). Submit a transfer request anytime between December 2, 2025 and by 4:00pm on Tuesday, April 8, 2025, form linked here: English / Spanish). Families will get their transfer status notification by the end of that week.
- *All 5th grade families will complete the 6th grade verification process in March 2025. It is not your final decision point, it will just give us a sense of what you are thinking.
- *All 5th grade families will receive a survey via ParentSquare on Monday, April 7th to respond to your final decision. The final decisions reply deadline is Friday, April 11th

We will also be having School Transition Update Cafecitos if you would like to hear updates in a more relaxed intimate setting while enjoying a cup of coffee and pastries with school administration.



Late Drop Offs:

All students will have to walk on their own to their classroom if they arrive late to class (parents are not to walk to

classrooms after the school day has started as this will interrupt the flow of classroom procedures).

The only exception to this is TK students, they may be walked to their class by parents if they arrive late. Kinder to 6th grade students should walk to their classrooms on their own.

School Absences:

If you have any student out sick, not feeling well, your student will be late, or will be having a doctor's or dentist appointment please make sure you call our <u>main office at 650–312–7737</u>. After the 3rd day, if your student continues to be sick you will need to provide a doctors note to the office a week from the 3rd day missed. Please make sure you call <u>before 10:00am</u> on the day that your student will be absent and not the following day. If you don't notify us your student will be marked absent.

If your student is absent please make sure to bring a medical note as soon as the next day or when your student returns to school so that we may correct their attendance with enough time.
