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Types of CCP Courses

1. Embedded

- Offered at McNick
- Taught by a McNick teacher

2. On-campus/Online

- Offered at the college campus
- Taught by a college professor

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Through Cincinnati State

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On-Campus/Online

- Classes follow the college's calendar.
- Student given a CCP study hall to work on the class during the school day.
- Choose with intentionality.
- Requires responsibility and independence by the STUDENT!

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Process for all

- Meet with your high school counselor.
- Apply to the college by March 15.*
- Complete the funding application by April 1.*
- Send the funding award letter to the college.
- Attend the college's virtual orientation.
- Follow all deadlines set forth by the college.
- Check your college email regularly!



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For On-campus/Online students

- Attend a virtual orientation.
- Meet with an advisor.
- Register for the course.

Note: Students who have only taken embedded courses at UC will need to complete the Modality Change form if planning an on-campus/online class.
