2025 Legislative Session

Priorities

- Increased funding for rural schools
- Accountability needs for any school choice legislation
- Stable funding for school districts with the transition back to Average Daily Attendance and protection for districts in regard to the 97% ADA
- Increase funding for Behavioral Programs
- Ola Elementary Rural School Discussion and Planning
 - Ola elementary currently has 10 students K-6 with 2 6th graders that will be moving to the Emmett Middle School in 2025
- Interest-Based Bargaining Planning meetings for Interest-Based Bargaining will begin in January, with the first meeting scheduled for January 14th.
- Idaho School Board Association Day on the Hill February 17th and 18th
- Emmett School District has requested Idaho High School Association consider a mid-cycle move for Emmett High School from the 5A classification to th 4A based on our April 2024 appeal and the state data that confirms our numbers from November 2024
