

DATA FOCUS



Data Celebrations We are excited to celebrate some outstanding data achievements from our recent Istation testing! Istation is an assessment tool that helps track student progress in reading and math by identifying strengths and areas for growth. Our **1st-grade students** made incredible gains in both math and reading, while our **3rd-grade students** excelled in reading. A key highlight is the high Rate of Improvement (ROI) seen with our Tier 3 and Tier 2 students. ROI measures how quickly students are progressing toward grade-level proficiency, and high ROI means students are making rapid progress. In Istation, students are grouped into tiers: Tier 1 represents students performing at or above grade level, Tier 2 indicates students needing some additional support, and Tier 3 identifies students requiring intensive intervention. While Tier 3 and Tier 2 students showed remarkable growth, Tier 1 students also demonstrated moderate and typical growth, which is essential for sustained success. These results reflect the hard work of our students and teachers, and we are proud to see such significant progress across these grade levels!
