

What is the Seal of Biliteracy?

This award is a state-level recognition of students who have studied and attained proficiency in two or more languages by high school graduation. This program recognizes high school graduates who have attained a high level of proficiency in speaking, reading, and writing one or more languages in addition to English.



How do students get recognized?

- Senior Awards Night
- A seal on your high school diploma
- A cord to wear at graduation



Requirements - part 1

- English language arts requirements for graduation with an overall grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 in those classes.

OR

- Option 1: State Assessment: (CAASPP)
- Option 2: Advanced Placement (AP) Assessment
- Option 3: International Baccalaureate (IB) Assessment
- Option 4: SAT: Achieve a score of 480 or above on the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing section of the SAT.
- ELD students need to also get a 4 on the ELPAC test

Requirements - part 2

Successfully complete a four-year course of study in a world language at the highschool or higher level, attaining an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher

OR

- Option 1: AP
- Option 2: IB
- Option 3: ACTFL
- Option 4: District-Approved Assessment



We will continue having common finals and common final projects.




