Rainbow After-School and Preschool programs provide a nurturing learning environment for children 3 yrs – 13 yrs. Our program encourages the development of a strong self-esteem and feeling of competence. At Rainbow, we believe in low Teacher-child ratios, further enhancing our students' emotional and academic growth.

Preschool Class – 1 Teacher for 6 Students
TK-K Classes – 1 Teacher for 8 children
1st Grade – 3rd Grade – 1 Teacher for 9 children
4th Grade – 7th Grade – 1 Teacher for 9 children

Our staff have been selected for their educational background as well as their warmth and patience. All staff have completed a state clearance, classroom training and probation period. Some of our staff are bilingual in Spanish and many are CPR certified.

Our 1st – 7th grade students are required to participate in homework study time daily. Supplies and staff are accessible for help. All children have daily nutritional snacks, access to crafts, organized games and outside playtime.

We are a year around program, only closing 12 days each year. We are open on some holidays and all Teachers service days. We offer a safe, fun filled programs during Summer and all schools breaks, which includes field trips, water activities, guest instructors and much more. Our operating hours are 6:30 am to 6:00 pm M-F. Including before school care with cereal & milk until 8:00 am. The children are walked over to line up and watched until entering the school.

Our tuition rates are approved for all state-paid child care programs for working parents with new higher income allowances, which are helping many more families to qualify to have their child's tuition paid year around.
