## Academic Overview

- Libertyville High School is on a two-semester system with an eight-period day.
- District 128 does not rank.

- Weighted and unweighted GPAs are computed at the end of fall, spring and summer semesters.
- GPAs are based on semester grades from all courses except Driver Education.

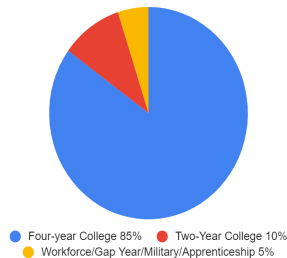
