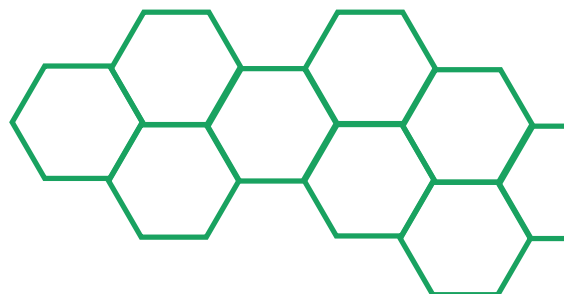

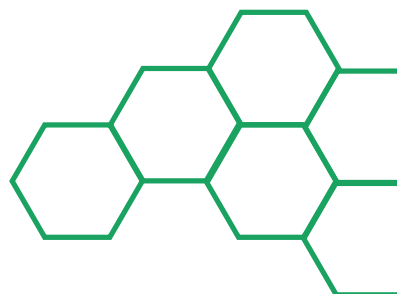

Career Exploration at Valley View



Exploring Careers, 20 Questions at a Time: Valley View's Innovative Learning Initiative

In the bustling library of Valley View Middle School, a unique group of students is reimagining career exploration—one professional at a time. The 20 in 20 group, brainchild of Jess McLennon, Edina Community Education's Career Exploration Coordinator, is breaking down the traditional barriers between middle school students and the professional world.

"When I first started working for Edina Community Ed, I wanted to introduce career exploration much earlier than high school," McLennon explains. Her vision was simple yet powerful: create a speaker series that would bring professionals directly into the school, sparking curiosity and opening windows to potential futures.

The group found its home during the school's flex hour, a strategic choice that minimizes classroom disruption while maximizing student engagement. Collaborating with library media specialist Angie Endo, McLennon discovered a

group of students eager to dive deeper into the world of careers.

Two of those students, Kyle Parmenter and Darsh Dev, have become pivotal leaders of the 20 in 20 subgroup. Their mission? To ask 20 questions to professionals in 20 minutes, uncovering the stories behind diverse careers.

"It's been eye-opening," Kyle shares, his enthusiasm evident. "We get to meet people with different professions and learn about paths we might never have considered." For Kyle, the group is more than just a school activity—it's a glimpse into potential future directions, a chance to explore college and career possibilities.

Darsh echoes this sentiment, highlighting a recent visit from an architect and designer. "They showed us a house design online and walked us through their process," he explains. "It's something we wouldn't have gotten to learn without this group."

The professionals who visit are carefully selected

based on student interests. McLennon works closely with the students, curating a speaker list that reflects their curiosity. From interior designers to authors, each visitor brings a unique perspective to the middle school audience.

For Darsh, who has harbored a specific career dream since childhood, the group remains a source of excitement. "Working together with my friends and leading these sessions has been awesome," he says. Even with a long-held career aspiration, he finds joy in learning about the vast landscape of professional opportunities.

The 20 in 20 group represents more than just career exploration—it's about breaking down barriers, fostering curiosity, and empowering students to envision their futures. By bringing professionals directly into the school environment, McLennon and her student leaders are creating a dynamic learning experience that extends far beyond traditional classroom walls.

As middle school students like Kyle and Darsh continue to lead and learn, the 20 in 20 group stands as a testament to the power of early career exposure. It's a program that doesn't just show students what jobs exist—it inspires them to imagine what they might become.

Community Ed cannot offer refunds or credits for cancellations received less than one business day before the start of a class. Participants will be notified by email and/or SMS if there is a change in the date/location of the class. If the class is canceled you will be notified by a phone call and/or email. Edina Community Ed confirms registrations via email with participants who include their email addresses in their family profile.

Check-In and Emergency Contact Information

We look forward to making sure that your child not only has a great time this summer, but also is safe while in our care. We ask that you help us by following the guidelines below.

- Students enrolled in a camp or class during the summer should be checked in and out of the camp by a parent or caregiver unless otherwise arranged.
- We request written permission (email is acceptable) from a parent or guardian when a student will be leaving the building on their own.
- Please make sure that your emergency contact information is current and that any special needs or allergies are included in your child's profile.

Prorating

We do not prorate classes or camps. Classes are designed to allow enough time to complete course curriculum.

Weather

Refunds are not available due to inclement weather, i.e., extreme heat or rain. We reserve Friday of each week as a rain date for outdoor camps.

Late Pick-Up Fees

Parents or caregivers arriving later than 5 minutes past the end of class will be charged \$1 per minute. Payment is due at pick-up.

Non-Discrimination Policy

Data Privacy

While you may choose to register without this information, there may be consequences that could limit the distribution of information to the participant (e.g., no team roster or class confirmation). Access to contact information is limited to individuals involved in the activity.

Unless you notify Edina Community Ed, photos taken within community ed classes/programs/activities may be included in Edina Community Ed publications.

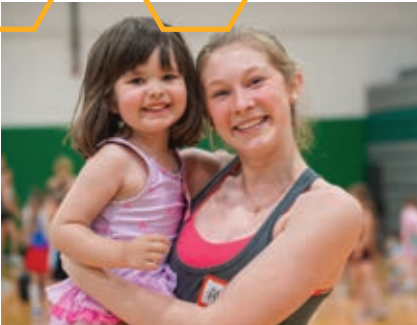
