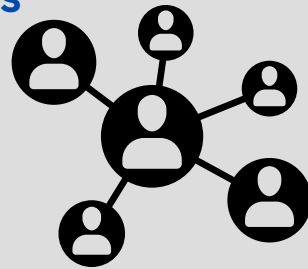


Orange County Department of Mental Health Services

- ✓ Trained counselors assist those in need of support for mental illness, substance use, developmental disability, and sexual assault. In addition to telephone support, they will help connect callers to appropriate services, they can dispatch the Mobile Response Team to assist with in-home support, assessment, and crisis de-escalation, and can also refer callers to a Certified Peer Support Worker to provide in person support and assistance with engaging and navigating the system or connecting to services.
