SOPHOMORES & JUNIORS

Save the Date - State/District ACT for all juniors and PreACT for all sophomores will be February 25, 2025.

The State/District ACT is an opportunity for every junior to take the ACT at no cost to their family. Scores from this ACT administration could assist students in earning the <u>College</u> <u>Readiness Seal</u> for graduation and assist in their college search.

The PreACT provides sophomores with a jumpstart to their college and career planning. By taking the PreACT as a sophomore, students will have the opportunity to get a feel for the content, timing and scoring of the ACT, but they'll also be able to:

- Identify your current academic readiness for college and career using your PreACT score report
- Predict how you'll perform on the ACT after an additional year of learning
- Determine skills you can improve based on your performance
- Explore with PreACT assessment how your career aspirations align with your interests

The PreACT will be administered online. This is to ensure students have an opportunity to take an online version of the ACT before the ACT makes changes in 2025.

The State/District ACT will be administered on paper. Our juniors have already practiced the ACT on paper and will continue with that format. Changes to the National ACT will not begin until the end of the junior year. With the new enhancements to the National ACT, students will be able to choose if they will test online or on paper.
