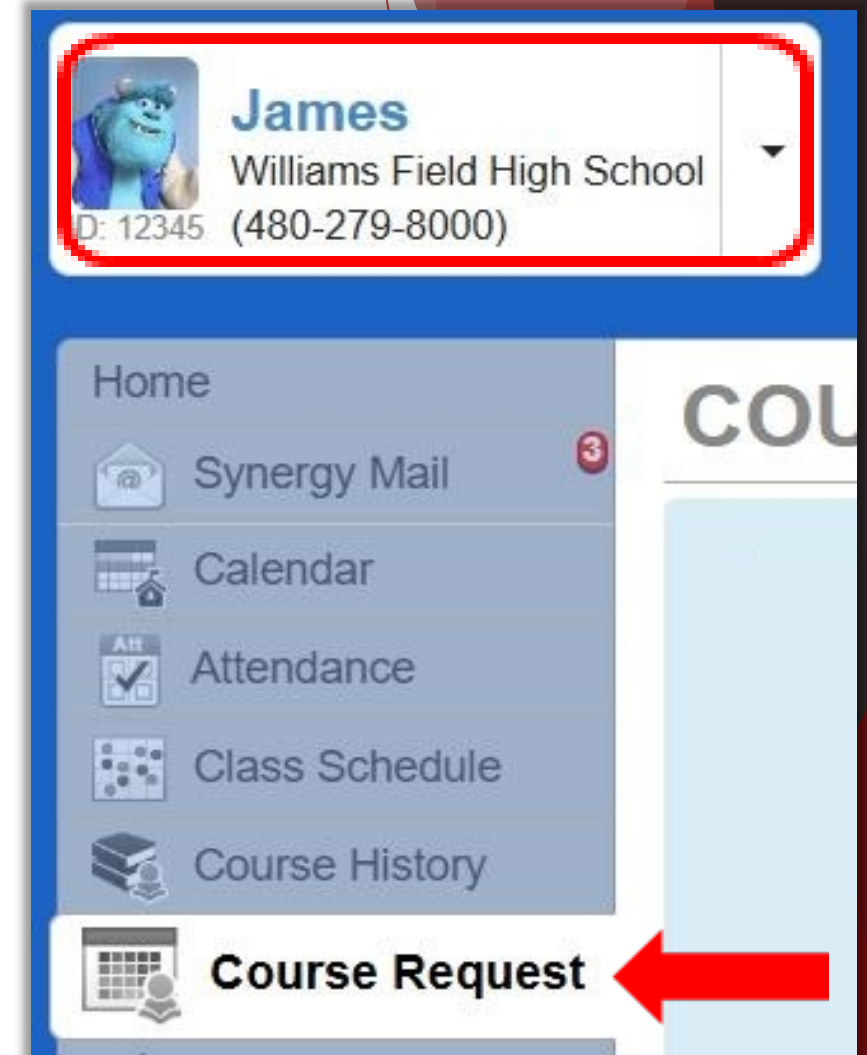

# Online Course Registration

- ▶ This year students will be registering for classes through StudentVue.
- ▶ Use the Course Planning template in your packet to pick your classes before going online to enter them in StudentVue
- ▶ Some classes have already been pre-selected for you based off of your current courses - you can change these if you were placed in the wrong level of a class or would like to change the recommended course for next year (we strongly recommend talking to your teachers about your course options for next year)



# Online Course Registration Continued

## ▶ Course Selection

- ▶ Remember to add the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester section for each class you pick
- ▶ You need to ensure you have the required core classes for next year and add your top elective choices
  - ▶ You should have 6 classes selected (a total of 14 sections including lunch for both semesters)

# Hybrid Students

- ▶ If you plan to take one or more classes online next year through Higley Virtual Academy, you will be able to indicate this through your online course registration
- ▶ Please search “HVA” under Course Search and select the appropriate HVA sections to indicate your plan to take the identified subject area online
- ▶ You can take 1, 2, 4, or 5 classes online as a Hybrid student.
  - ▶ You cannot take 3 classes online and 3 classes in-person as you need to have a primary campus.

# More on Electives:

► Some things to keep in mind when selecting electives:

- ❑ 1 PE credit is needed for graduation (must be a class in your schedule)
  - ❑ Dance, Marching Band/Color Guard can fulfill a PE or Fine Art Credit
  - ❑ Freshman Weights & Athletic Weights - if you plan to play a sport at WFHS, you may be required to take an Athletic Weights class - please talk to your counselor if this could apply to you!
  - ❑ Freshman Weights is a 2-hour block 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> hour. Please sign up for the class twice during registration
- ❑ 1 fine art or CTE (Career & Technical Education)
- ❑ World language is not required for graduation from WFHS - however most 4-year universities will require that you took 2 years in high school



# More on Electives:



Students are expected to take 6 credit hours each year 9th through 11th grade.

# Online Course Registration Complete by 1/28/24

Counselors will be following up with students to review their course registration on 1/28 and 1/30.

The online registration must be COMPLETELY filled out to be accepted. Counselors will not meet with you if you have not entered your courses for next year.

If you are planning to take Honors or AP classes please make sure parents login to ParentVue and “Lock-In” your course selections - this takes the place of a parent signature on the Honors Academic Agreement form.

Please note: We will not take teacher requests, period requests or lunch time requests.
