The mean SAT score for TABS' 11th-graders hasn't broken 1000 since 2021. It's time for that to change.

All 11th-graders at TABS are scheduled to take the SAT for free March 11. A high SAT score can result in more college options and higher scholarship totals. It can also <u>exempt a</u> <u>student from the TSIA</u>.

Students can study using the Bluebook app. It's already on their FWISD laptops and can be <u>downloaded for</u> <u>personal devices here</u>.
