- Commit to participating in the Metro RESA Read Aloud Challenge by completing the read aloud challenge each day of February
- Deliver Dynamic Read-Alouds: Use expressive voices, gestures, and pacing to bring the story to life and keep students engaged.
- Ask questions, encourage predictions, and invite students to share their thoughts during and after the reading.
