MARTHA & JOSH MORRISS MATHEMATICS & ENGINEERING ELEMENTARY PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVES 2022-2023

Goal 1: Produce students who possess the skills and knowledge that enable them to be future-ready citizens and leaders in the global workforce through access to state-of-the-art facilities.

- Objective 1: Regarding STAAR testing, 100% of Morriss students will reach the achievement level "Approaching", 100% of Morriss students will reach the achievement level "Meets", and 80% of Morriss students will reach the achievement level "Masters" by May 2023.
- Objective 2: All Morriss teachers will learn, understand, and implement the model of cooperative learning and student engagement through participating in Kagan Cooperative Learning professional development by May 2023.

Goal 2: All students will experience learning that encourages innovation, leadership, and academic growth in safe, engaging, and technologically advanced classrooms.

- Objective 1: Morriss Elementary will continue necessary steps to complete Phase 1 of the 3-year plan to obtain the National Institute of Stem Education Campus requirements by May 2023.
- Objective 2: Morriss Elementary will be immersed in a technologically-enhanced environment by February 2023.

- Objective 3: Instructional Coach will support all Morriss teaching staff through weekly lesson planning, weekly classroom walk throughs, Learning Walks, and data meetings after each summative assessment during the 2022-2023 school year.

- **Goal 4:** Each student will experience a school and community partnership that provides access to resources designed to anticipate and nourish student needs.
- Objective 1: Morriss Elementary will receive 60% student participation, 90% staff participation, and 50% family participation on the spring 2023 Leader in Me Measurable Results Analysis.
- Objective 2: Morriss students will engage in authentic learning in the form of a knowledgeable speaker or an off-campus field trip at the rate of 1 per six weeks per grade level during the 2022-2023 school year.
- Objective 3: Morriss students will plan, lead and host a minimum of two engineering encounters annually.
