Transition Process



1

CCHS special education admin & chair meet with middle school Special Ed Teams to discuss programming

2

CCHS/ Middle school Special education staff consult on each student and propose services that align with the student's current IEP

3

Transition is discussed at the student's 8th grade IEP meeting or through a transition meeting and reflected in the IEP

4

In the fall, the students and families will meet the new case manager

Study Skills

General Academic Support and skill instruction in executive functioning literacy skills development and self-advocacy tailored to individual IEP goals

Staffing

Special Education Teachers and Tutors

- Applying literacy strategies to classroom content
- Content specific skill development
- Organizational support
- Study skills
- Executive functioning
- Reading comprehension, written expression, and mathematics

Anchor

Programming for students with social-emotional challenges who have had minimal response to academic interventions and weekly counseling
A continuum of support ranging from counseling and study skills to sub-separate small classes

Staffing:

Special Education Teachers and Tutors
General Education Teachers
School Psychologist
Adjustment Counselor

- Individual weekly counseling
- Group counseling
- Academic Support
- Substantially separate core classes
- Co-taught classes
- Consult-liaison with teachers
- Crisis management /response
- Family communication/meetings

Bridge

Programming for students with Autism Spectrum Disorders and Social communication difficulties who struggle with connecting socially to peers, understanding social pragmatics skills, and have challenges with self-regulation and executive functioning skills

Staffing:

Special Education Teacher and Tutors
School Psychologist
Speech and Language Pathologist
Transition Specialist

- Academic support and instruction in executive functioning
- Individual counseling with school psychologist
- Consult-liaison with teachers
- Regular family communication
- Weekly social groups led by speech-language pathologist and/or school psychologist
- Development of age appropriate life/transition skills

Language and Beyond

Programming for students with language-based learning disabilities aligned with practice and pedagogy from Landmark school

Staffing:

Special Education Teachers and Tutors
General Education Partner Teacher
School Psychologist

- Small group English classes
- Co-taught and tutor-supported general education classes
- Academic support
- Instruction in executive functioning
- Consult-liaison with teachers
- Reading Skills, as outlined in IEP

Pathways

Programming for students with severe physical or cognitive disabilities which includes Individualized educational, social and vocational program.

Staffing:

Special Education Teachers and Tutors
General Education Inclusion Teachers
School Psychologist
Speech and Language Pathologist
OT
PT
Transition Specialist

- Small group instruction in ELA, Math, Life Skills and Vocational Development
- Inclusion opportunities on an individual basis
- Community events
- Individual and weekly counseling
- Individual and whole group speech and language instruction
- Access to OT/PT as outlined in IEP

Other Services

Math Workshop

Specially designed, explicit instruction for students with Math Goals on their IEPs

Staffing

Special Education Math tutors

- Speech language pathologist *SLP*
- Occupational Therapist *OT*
- Transition Specialist
- School Psychologists
