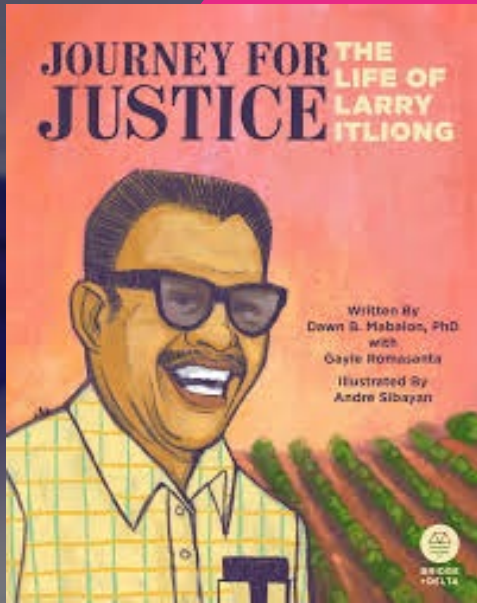

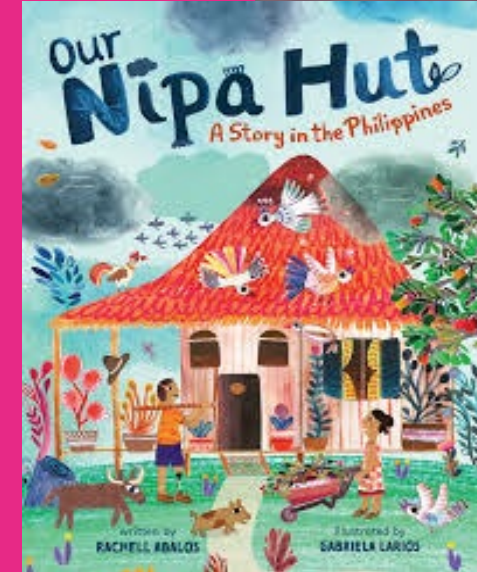

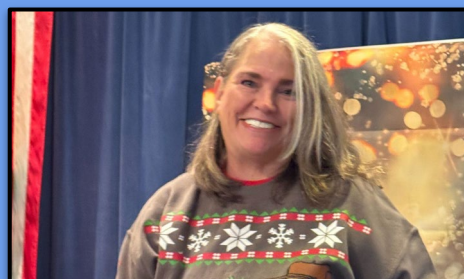

LAHS 8th Grade Orientation-Class of 2029!!

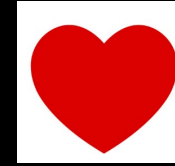
