

2025 Black History Theme: Honoring African Americans & Labor



What is Black History Month?

Black History Month is an annually observed month-long celebration of African American life, History, and culture. Founded by Dr. Carter G. Woodson in February 1926, what was formerly known as Negro History Week became a month-long celebration as a way to

promote, research, preserve, interpret, and disseminate information about Black life, history, and culture to the global community. The Association for the Study of African American Life and History (ASALH) was formed to carry on the legacy of Dr. Woodson by disseminating knowledge about Black History.

The 2025 Black History Month theme is African Americans and Labor, which focuses on the various and profound ways that work and working of all kinds - free and unfree, skilled, and unskilled, vocational and voluntary – intersect with the collective experiences of Black people. Indeed, work is at the very center of much of Black history and culture. Check out ASALH at asalh.org!


